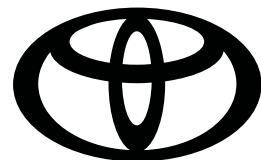

FINALS - QUALIFYING/ELIMINATION RECORD STORY

Finals Action and Junior Awards

With the end of the home and away season the focus now turns to both awards nights and finals.

The junior best & fairest dinner was held last Wednesday at the Ballarat Trotting Club with votes counted for the under 18 and under 15 competitions. The under 18 best & fairest winner was a runaway victory for Springbank's Archie Geyle with a total of 38 votes. He was nine votes clear of Luke Ozols from Learmonth and Newlyn's Tom Hindhaugh finishing third a further five votes behind Luke. Archie is in his first season in the league and was a significant contributor in the CHFL Under 18 interleague victory over Colac DFL. Nathan Jolly from Waubra is the winner of the under 18 goal kicking award with 48 goals, just two goals clear of Jack French from Daylesford.

The under 15 best & fairest award was another definitive win this time to Brendan Monaghan, Daylesford, also with 38 votes from the sixteen matches played. It was a much more exciting count for the runner up position with a three-way tie between Kipp McLeod (Creswick), Riley Shillito (Gordon) and Walter Orwin (Buninyong) who each earned 32 votes from the season. The under 15 goal kicking award was also a close finish with Jy Phelps (Springbank) leading going into last weeks final round of matches, but with Springbank having the bye it provided the opportunity for Ziggy Dark (Rokewood Corindhap) to make up the six-goal deficit he started the day on with a haul of eight against Beaufort and finish with a two-goal lead on 46 goals. Well done to both Ziggy and Jy on excellent seasons in front of goal. Both will continue into the finals and can be important members in their club's effort to win a premiership.

The final round of matches in the senior grade competition has highlighted the even nature of the competition with most in the top eight approaching the finals with a lot of confidence to go with the hope that all will be feeling. Springbank was able to retain top spot despite having the bye which justifies their performance across most of the season after early season losses and who they are going to meet in the initial qualifying final out of the top four probably will matter little due to the evenness of this group and Bungaree who may look to be the most vulnerable following three defeats in the final four rounds will need to improve. It took the Tigers about half the season to get their team settled and their best team available. An important addition was the return of key forward Stephen Stanton who has enabled the balance of the team to return and players such as Shannon Donegan and Todd Finco to have the best impact they can in more suited roles. The class of Finco has been added to this year with the addition of recruits Brant Haintz and Fergus Toose, who along with James Thompson now have one of the best midfields available to any club.

Bungaree meanwhile is showing an almost opposite form progression due in part to injury and the wear and tear of a long season where they were the league leader and the target each week. They have had enormous seasons from former Geoff Taylor Medalist Joel Mahar, John Butler and captain Andrew Milroy who is possibly in his best form of the season in recent weeks.

Also, the impact of Thomas Elliott in the forward line has been an important factor in the second half of the year for the Demons. They will be hoping to get key midfielder Ben Dodd back from injury for this clash but it will not be easy for him to be in top form after several rounds out. Based upon the past month of competition Springbank will start as favourites in this match at Buninyong.

Gordon and Hepburn have ended up in third and fourth spots with the chance to play for progress into the other preliminary final and a welcome week off. Both teams played most of their expected teams last weekend but probably had different levels of performance with Creswick making it a much harder task for the Burras compared to Gordon's victory over Ballan. Adam Toohey remains a very dangerous target for Gordon finishing the home and away season with 65 goals five behind Hepburn's Andy McKay who has won the

Shane Everard Memorial Goal Kicking Award with 70 for the season, but Hepburn are likely to be without McKay for a few weeks at least and it is going to be a big task for him to get back at all this season following foot surgery.

Gordon has a group of tall defenders available, Zack Ryan, Mark Gunnell and Macauley Griffith in particular, who will make it difficult for Hepburn to score easily. Whether they will match up with Jackson Carrick when he goes forward will be a key question for the Gordon leadership. Whilst at the other end of the ground they have been able to rely on a few goals each week from Brendan Sutcliffe as the tall target, Connor Ascoug and Billy Griffiths drifting forward from the midfield to add to Toohey's contribution. Ricky Ferraro, Bradley McKay, Dan O'Halloran and Mitchell McKay all provide enormous talent and experience in the mid field to match against the Eagles leaders in the middle of the ground; Tye Murphy, Jaymes Gorman and Rohan Clampit. Gordon have had the edge against most challengers this year and should be able to make another preliminary final. The elimination finals shape as bringing together four clubs who appear to be close in talent and form.

Carngham Linton are going into their first ever senior finals series in the CHFL and have a lot of talent across the ground which should make them a formidable opponent for Newlyn who pushed the Saints in round 13 at Carngham. Carngham Linton welcomed back their key player Nicholas O'Brien back into the team after injury last week and his impact was obvious. He was vital in keeping his team in contact early against a good Clunes performance. He gets the ball out of stoppages far more than any other player in the league and this allows the strong smaller runners of Kynan and Tarun Raven, Sam O'Loughlin and Dean O'Brien who also add a great deal of strength at the contest around the ground.

Newlyn do bring a strong defensive unit into the match lead by Jackson Starcevic who as a tall defender is equal to any in the CHFL who does have the ability to go forward if needed. The Cats will get coach Marcus Darmody back after a week off so Starcevic is more likely to go back to his normal role. Newlyn's midfield is a good unit lead by Callum Currie who has been one of the leading players this season, accompanied by the Dylan Fishwick, Sean Willmott and Paddy Labbett. The major challenge for this group is to make sure they make deep entries into the forward line to give Darmody the best chance to display his goal kicking accuracy. Newlyn appears to be more impacted by injuries late in the season and may find it hard to stop Carngham Linton's progress into the semi-finals.

The other elimination final at Waubra on Sunday brings together potentially two clubs that have the ability to really impact on the next couple of weeks of finals. Skipton are clearly going to bring confidence into the clash with their victory last week against Bungaree, but they have been stretched quite a bit during the season especially since they have been without the ball winning ability of Sam Willian. Mitch Gilbert has been a key, with good contributions by Daniel Kilpatrick and Matthew Romeril many weeks. Rhys Monument and Josh Draffin have been able to make the most of the opportunities in the forward line, but they are going to get it tough this week with experienced Dunnstown full back Patrick Britt going to make it a tough day for Monument as the deepest forward.

At the other end Skipton's strength has been Ben Krol and Nick Stangio in key defence positions where they have been under a lot of pressure many weeks, but have stood up as excellent contributors, particularly Krol, who is rarely beaten. Dunnstown though have a good key forward set up with the agile and strong Flynn Stevenson and Jack Leonard creating a strong target for a creative midfield. This match may be the closest of the four for the weekend and the loser of the Gordon v Hepburn match will not be looking forward to meeting the winner in the first semi-final next week.

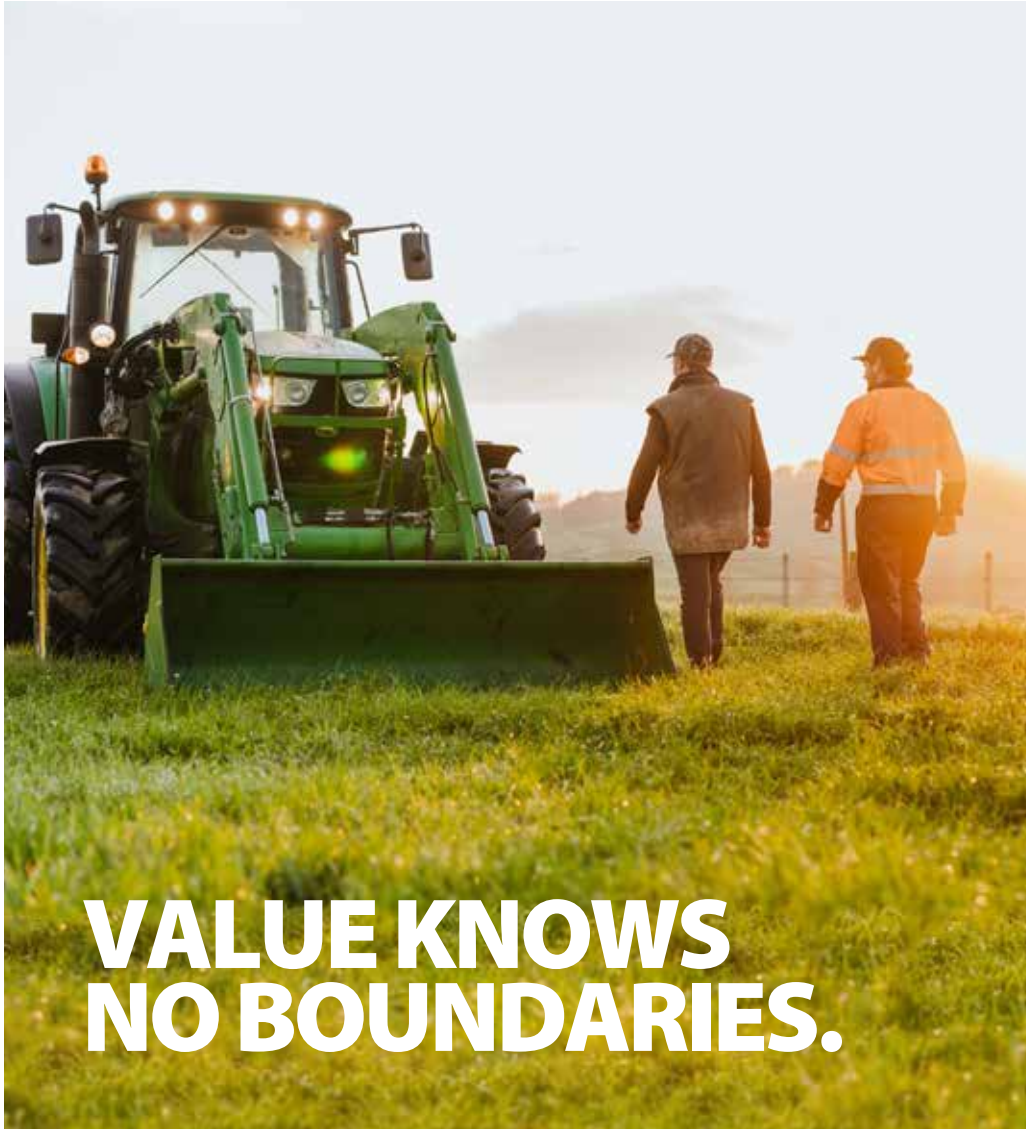

SPECTATOR BEHAVIOUR CODE

1. Encourage children to participate if they are interested. However, if a child is not willing do not force them.
2. Focus upon the child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event. This assists the child in setting realistic goals related to their ability by reducing the emphasis on winning.
3. Teach your child that honest effort is as important a victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
4. Encourage your child always to play by the rules.
5. Never ridicule or yell at your child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. Remember your child should be involved in football for their enjoyment, not yours.
7. Remember your child learns best by example. Applaud good play by both your team and by members of the opposing team.
8. If you disagree with an official or umpire raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the official's judgement and honesty in public. Remember, most officials give their time and effort for your child's involvement.
9. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abus from junior sporting activities.
10. Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give their time and resources to provide recreational activities for your child and deserve your support.
11. Support your club officials in maintaining the highest standard of behaviour both on and off the field for the betterment of the league and your family. Offer your assistance to the team that your child is playing in so that every opportunity is being provided for the very best supervision and support. Your involvement will give both yourself and your child far more satisfaction.
12. Avoid use of derogatory language based on gender or race.

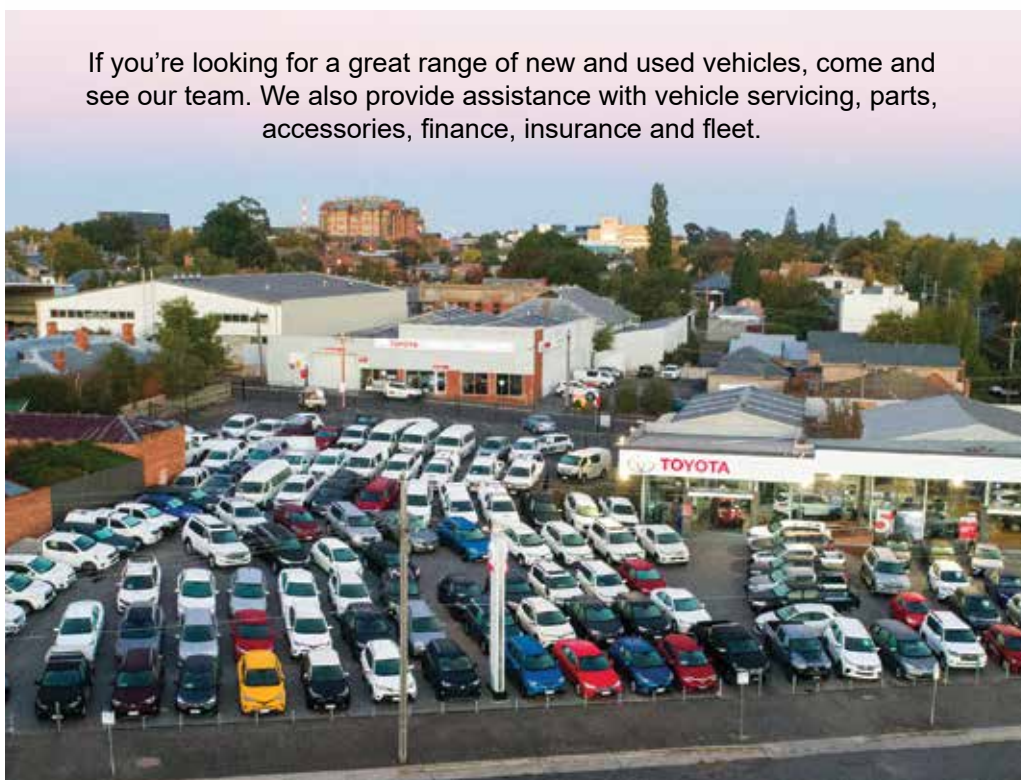
