FINALS - QUALIFYING/ELIMINATION RECORD STORY

The return of finals football last weekend brought a great deal of excitement and a chance for all of the top eight sides with the opportunity to show what they have in their armoury against evenly matched opponents.

Big crowds at all four venues highlighted the importance of community football and netball competitions to so many people and on top of that its importance as a way of getting people together to share each other's company.

It has been a feature of the CHFL and CHNL for decades and observing the conversations and laughter as people got together highlighted that it remains one of the great aspects of the league.

In the senior football matches all games ended up following the order of the top eight with first and second placed Springbank and Gordon winning the qualifying finals and moving into the preliminary finals on the 9th and 10th September respectively.

Each of these wins were comfortable and both clubs are sure to welcome the week off that they have this weekend to recover and be fully ready for their next big clashes.

The elimination finals also followed the same script with the fifth and sixth placed Carngham Linton and Skipton both progressing through to this weekends' semi final clashes, although Skipton got a massive scare from Dunnstown who looked to have the match sewn up with about 10 minutes to play

So, the end outcome was seventh Dunnstown and eighth placed Newlyn are finished after just the one final.

Both the Towners and Cats put up brave contests and will be disappointed that they were not able to push further into the finals.

Now the challenge for the semi-finalists is to try to recover after hard matches that left a few knocks and sore bodies at the least.

Bungaree have led the ladder until the last few rounds being undefeated until round 14 but have now lost four of their last five games, not defeating another team in the too eight.

So, they now need to turn this trend around in the semi final on Saturday against Carngham Linton or it might be seen as a wasted season for the Demons

Whilst they may not have been expected to be a top four team at the start of the season their form over the initial 13 rounds gave their supporters the hope that they would be able to at least win some finals.

They are relying a great deal on a few to score goals for them but John Butler, Jackson Murphy and Thomas Elliott have developed into a forward line who are able to make the most of the opportunities created up the ground.

Being able to get a few more goals through the midfield could make the difference of being able to break down Carngham Linton's resistance.

Andrew Milroy, Joel Mahar, Simon Butler and Dalton Murphy when they were at their best early in the season were breaking the lines with their run and setting up the vital goals that was breaking through opposition defence.

Carngham Linton's midfield strength is where they will stretch Bungaree if the Demon's are not able to retain control of the football.

Nick O'Brien, Dean O'Brien and Tyson Scoble all had a major impact last weekend in their win over Newlyn, with their ability to get extra distance in their kicking enabling their dangerous smaller forwards in Josh Foley and Matthew Knight to create havoc for defenders and set up Brad McDonald in front of goal.

Knight damaged a hamstring and his creativity will be missed but if Brad McDonald can kick another six goals this week the Saints are going to be well and truly in the contest.

Carngham Linton are in uncharted waters as a club in the CHFL, having never made senior finals before but they have a group of players who are bringing a lot of experience from strong competitions right through to AFL with Nick O'Brien and they showed enough last week against Newlyn to indicate that they should be in this contest against Bungaree all the way.

Carngham Linton could well find themselves heading into a preliminary final.

On Sunday Skipton are going to still be on a high after their thrilling win over Dunnstown at Waubra and will be desperate to progress into a preliminary final after just falling short at the semi final stage last year.

Rhys Monument is in excellent form finishing with a match winning five goals last week and he is going to be a hand full for whoever Mitch Banner sends back onto him, most likely Finn Anscombe.

If so, it will be a contest worth keeping a close eye on as they are two of the best in the league.

Another key clash will be in the ruck between Hepburn's Sean Tighe and Skipton's Patrick Graham. Graham had a major impact in the elimination final, decreasing the influence of Dunnstown's dangerous Khyle Forde and he is going to take on a similar role against Tighe.

If Sean Tighe's ability to set up the dangerous Hepburn midfield is nullified it will give Skipton's equally dangerous smaller brigade the chance to set up their forward line.

A concern for Skipton will be the fitness of vital defender Ben Krol who left the ground in the final quarter of the elimination final. He has a major role breaking down many oppositions attacking moves each week and being without him for a whole game would leave a major hole for Chris Banwell to try to fill.

Especially as Krol may have been the first choice to go to the dangerous Jackson Carrick from Hepburn.

Hepburn are a very experienced club when it comes to finals and there are few in their senior side who don't know how to play finals football. Being able to absorb the pressure when their opponent has some momentum but then pounce when their opportunity arrives is one of the features of this outstanding club.

Skipton play in a hectic manner and this will test the Burras.

The winner from the Bungaree vs Carngham Linton will play Gordon in the second preliminary final and the Hepburn vs Skipton proceeds to face the Springbank in the first semi final on Saturday 9th September.



SPECTATOR BEHAVIOUR CODE

- Encourage children to participate if they are interested. However, if a child is not willing do not force them.
- Focus upon the child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event.

- Teach your child that honest effort is as important a victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.

- Remember your child should be involved in football for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Remember your child learns best by example. Applaud good play by both your team and by members of the opposing team.

- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abus from junior sporting activities.

- 11. Support your club officials in maintaining the highest standard of behaviour both on and off the field for the betterment of the league and your family. Played at Learmonth, in almost perfect weather conditions, the contest was a tight affair for the best part of three quarters. That was until the Eagles surged with four last quarter goals to emphatically claim victory.

Hepburn dominated early in the opening quarter with 7 of the first 10 inside 50's. The play was in their forward half for a large percentage of the first 12 minutes, but they could only manage one goal as the Gordon defence worked overtime denying them easy disposals. Momentum then shifted with the green and gold onballers gaining first possession from stoppages. Macauley Griffiths opened the Eagle's scoring with a perfect set-shot goal before his mate Conner Ascough followed a minute later with a crafty snap goal. Two minutes after that, forward pressure rewarded the dashing Ben Schiltz with another Eagle goal. It was then the "Burras" turn to take control, but they failed to fully capitalise on repeated forward entries. At the 25th minute mark, Jordan Clampit zigged and zagged his way through opponents to sneer Gordon's fourth straight major, which gave his side an 8 point advantage at quarter time.


