Truro Takers Basketball Club endorses the following code of behaviour for players participating in its basketball programs and requires all players participating in this program to abide by this code.

The code is intended to assist everyone to obtain the maximum benefit and enjoyment from their involvement in basketball.

*Coaches will be the first point of contact if you have any issues, complaints or concerns.

*It is up to each coach to make contact with all of their teams' parents regarding training and game times

*It is up to a parent and player to discuss any concerns or issues with the coach.

*As a club we would like the opportunity for our coaches to rectify any issues and that may arise and deal with them accordingly.

*Players to ensure they have an open dialog with the coach regarding any behavioural issues.

*As a coach, it is their responsibility to ensure the team is a happy and safe environment for all

What is your goal?

- Build positive rapport with fellow team members
- Be respectful and supportive to opposition teams and coaches
- Facilitate positive barracking from spectators
- Ensure a fair game for everyone
- Utilise effective and constructive communication with players, parents, coaches and referees
- No coach, player or spectator is to approach a green shirt referee
- It is up to each individual player to ensure everyone in their team feels part of the team and respected
- Belittling, put downs and negativity will NOT be tolerated.

*There will be no swearing or yelling at players (yours or opposition), coaches, spectators or referees. This behaviour will not be tolerated by the Truro Basketball Club and may result in appropriate consequences as deemed fit by the club management.

What is your role?

- Participate in the pre-game huddles, encourage fair play and be a good sport
- Respect all calls made by the referees, play by their rules
- Follow the directions of the coach, referees and officials
- Spectators who refuse to adhere to the Codes of Behaviour will be removed from the venue
- Any issues need to be brought to the coaches attention. If there is an issue with a coach, please direct your issues to the team manager or club president.

*At the Truro Basketball Club we expect that each player is treated fairly and given the opportunity to shine and be comfortable to approach their coach with any concerns.
