GRAND FINAL INTRODUCTION

After the biggest weekend of preliminary finals the Brand Central Highlands Football League has ever seen all is now ready for the top two in each grade of football to see who is able to accept the challenge of becoming premiers.

Despite Mars Stadium being under construction with new grand stands it is potentially going to be the most exciting atmosphere ever experienced as the usual crowd attendance at the start of the senior grand final will go close to filling all the seats within the stadium.

The Old Scoreboard Hill will be out of action this year so the booth will be moved in under the western grandstand closest to where the old scoreboard was previously located.

It is an early start on grand final day with the under 15 match getting underway at 8.30am, between Learmonth and Skipton.

The Lakies have been a leading team in the competition throughout the season, losing just the one match for the season and amassing a massive 1066 percentage.

Skipton finished the home and away season in second spot, also on 15 wins, with the only loss of the season to Learmonth.

When these two teams met last in round 7 Learmonth at home had a large 49 point win over the Emus. This game should be closer than this when they meet to start grand final day off.

Learmonth has also been the dominant side in the under 18 grade, currently undefeated for the season, but they coming up against fourth placed on the ladder Rokewood Corindhap who have quite a few players in the group that were part of the Under 15 premiership side two years ago.

These two clubs met recently in round 14 which Learmonth won by 31 points but it was in very wet and deteriorating ground conditions which probably does not give a true indication of what will be experienced this Saturday.

The reserves grade match brings together second placed Dunnstown, and sixth placed Buninyong after the Bombers caused an upset over Springbank who were favoured to progress in the preliminary final last Saturday.

Buninyong have been able to bring in quite a few with good senior experience during the season for the finals, whereas Dunnstown are going to be impacted by the senior team dropping out of the race last weekend meaning that a few of their senior players returning from injury are not able to play in the reserves

These two last played back in round 7 when the Towners were able to set up a three-goal win, but it looks as though the two teams will be quite different in make up since the previous clash.

Then when the day progresses through to the last match of the season, the senior's grand final between Skipton and Daylesford is going to be the first grand final meeting between these two clubs.

Daylesford has been a regular grand final participant since it joined the CHFL back in 2006 but they had been in a bit of a drought before their premiership

A victory this year would be the first back-to-back premierships for the Bulldogs in the Brandt CHFL.

Whereas Skipton have spent 14 years building towards this first Brandt CHFL senior grand final since they joined the CHFL in 2011 along with Carngham Linton, Rokewood Corindhap and Smythesdale.

The Emus have been close for the past two seasons, especially last year when they lost to Daylesford in the preliminary final, but they have taken a clear step forward again this year, especially over the past month.

Skipton (3rd) and Daylesford (4th) have progressed through after wins in their qualifying finals against first and second placed Dunnstown and Gordon.

The weeks break appeared to help both last weekend when they were each able to overall control of their preliminary final clashes against the Towners and Eaules.

Whoever wins this week will clearly rank as the best team for the season as they will have had to defeat the other three top four finishes during the finals.

It is expected that there will be a contrast of styles between the two clubs, Skipton preferring to spread the football wide and moving it quickly into a broad range of scoring options, Daylesford in contrast is happy to getting into a stoppage game and allow their mature bodied players to take control.

Although it should be remembered that last Sunday against Gordon at Learmonth the Buildogs showed a more expansive style which they can revert to especially if they gain control of the stoppages.

A key battle from the outset will between the two best ruckmen in the league, Patrick Graham from Skipton and Ben Jones at Daylesford.

Each have enjoyed multiple recognition in the CHFL over the past few years, including this years Ballarat Trophies and Gifts Team of the Season representation.

They will be an even match in height but then contrast in Jones playing a traditional kick behind the play ruck role and Graham becoming more of a mobile midfield and forward.

Patrick Graham is probably more dangerous when he goes forward but Ben Jones can take crucial marks deep in defence.

Other midfielders who then will go to work after the ruck contest include some of the best who have been in the league over the past few seasons.

Former Geoff Taylor medallist Mitch Gilbert has returned to Skipton late in the season and has been having an impact immediately adding extra ball winning ability to go with the work of this year's medal runner up Jacob Maddock, Ben Lusby and a mix of others such as Jack McClure, Rhys Monument and Liam Phillips.

This group though will come across a physically stronger group than themselves when they meet Chris Peart, Travis Dean, Matthew Dean and Jordan Schroder.

As with all matches who controls this midfield will gain an advantage.

Over the past two seasons when conditions have been dry Skipton has been able to get good momentum over the Bulldogs in this area, but the converse has been the case if the football gets caught up in stoppages.

Both clubs have good options up forward as would be expected of teams who have been able to make it through to a grand final.

Daylesford's most versatile player Chris Molivas became their most dangerous forward last week and was able to take control of the game and was then supported by Trent Lee and Dion Lawson at the fall of the contest.

Skipton probably has a couple of options to use with Mitch Walsh and Nick Strangio who are both in form lock down defenders for Daylesford's forwards.

The risk for Skipton though might be will they then have enough to keep an eye on the other small forwards such as Jake Briggs or Matthew Dean and John O'Brien has become a good target deep in attack.

Jack Peeters might be strong enough to match up with O'Brien and Luke Delahey, and Alex McLean who have been important role players for the Emus will get important inbs.

Skipton probably have a broader range of forward options than that which occurred against Gordon last Sunday and will be important if Daylesford's structure can be solit up.

Daylesford has been able to set up a spare man in defence when they play at their best, often Riley Barrack and even Ben Jones as a further loose marking ontion.

The Emus might be able to break this important structure through using a range of options who can rotate through their deep forward options, in particular Jesse Palmer, Josh Draffin and Bailey McKimmie.

What they will need to do is to find a way to make Barrack accountable through keeping Aidan Lambert, Bryce Williams and Adam Leonard all responsible for their direct opponents and make Barrack responsible for an extra target.

If Skipton can get the game played in space they might have the speed to open up the Buildogs, but Daylesford are prepared to back their system of not letting the ball get out into space and use the spare defender to cut off supply within scoring range.

Ladder leader for D grade, Bungaree, didn't make it through with Dunnstown turning the tables last week. Dunnstown meet Buninyong instead so second plays third in what should be a thriller. Dunnstown had the edge by 6 in the Qualifying final and they are certainly up and about and will be coming in to this game full of confidence. Buninyong got the win by the same margin in the home and away rounds though so they also know they have the ability to get the win.

Hepburn and Bungaree meet to battle for the C grade premiership and these two teams have been the benchmark for the C grade competition all year finishing top two. They have not met in finals yet and the home and away round went the way of Bungaree by 14 goals but it was all the way back in round one, so this really is anyone's game. They will end the season the same way they started it but will the result be different?

Round 15, just over a month ago, Hepburn beat Springbank in the B grade competition by 16 goals and with both teams only having one loss each during the season, and with strong finals campaigns, both teams will be coming in to today full of fire and the knowledge that this game is within reach. 

- A cleaning fee will apply if banners are not removed from the Mars Stadium venue.




2025 GRAND FINAL - MARS STADIUM SITE PLAN
