The AFL Goldfields Under 17 team were successful in the opening game of their Far North Queensland trip on Sunday, defeating AFL Cairns at Cazaly's Stadium in Cairns by 76 points.

After a fast start, with a seven goal to one opening quarter, AFL Goldfields able to keep distance between themselves and AFL Cairns, increasing their lead at every break before running away with the game to win handsomely.

All seven RDFNL players were important in the win. Melton Centrals big man Majur Mamur was solid up forward, kicking three goals and creating plenty of chances at ground level. Rupertswood trio Dylan Landt, Bailee Revell and Dylan Featon all impressed with their run and carry, the toughness of Melton's Blake Souter and Sunbury Lion Brad Bernacki stood out and Kilmore's Liam Middleton's calmness under pressure was a feature

RIDDELL v MACEDON MATCH REVIEW

Riddell coach, Troy Scoble, had plenty to celebrate on his birthday as his team stormed to a 24-point win over Macedon at home on Saturday. The Cats led by 10 points early in the third term before the Bombers kicked seven unanswered goals to record their best win of the season.

Both teams went into the game on the back of two losses from as many games against teams in the top six. Macedon was without stars, Jack Mills (injury) and James Ferry (VFL,) while Riddell welcomed back Brian Ruffell up forward.

The visitors started strongly with the opening two goals from star forward Marcus Kenny to send the lead out to 11 points at the eight-minute mark of the term. Riddell broke the game apart with four goals in six minutes to push the lead out to 12 points. When Kenny kicked his third for the Cats in time-on of the term, it was game on.

The second term was an arm-wrestle. Macedon skipper, James Wright, and Kenny kicked early goals to restore the lead for the Cats who took a five-point lead into the half-time break. The last seven minutes of the term was marred with constant turnovers and neither side able to play consistent, clean football.

Clint Burgess and Teghan Henderson were easily the best in the first half for the Cats, doing everything as pleased and winning more ball than the midfielders. When Liam Gardiner kicked a goal three minutes into the third term, the Cats kicked away to a 10-point lead.

Henderson's dominance in the first half was stopped in the second half. He matched up on Riddell's Haydn Ross in a move that swung the game back in Riddell's favour. Ross and Ruffell went goal for goal as the pair shared five goals in 10 minutes to gain a 19-point lead and turn the game completely on its head. Matt Panuccio dominated in the middle while Ethan Foreman was unstoppable across half-back.

When Ross kicked his third goal at the eight-minute mark of the final term, the margin was out to 36 points. The Cats rallied and closed the margin down to 18 points late in time-on with time still remaining on the clock but Rhys Lowry's goal from the goal square sealed the deal and a big win for the Bombers. The Cats were left to ponder about

their second successive fade-out.


Birthday boy and Riddell coach, Troy Scoble, could not have been happier with the win.

"I thought it was a really good game, after the first 2.5 quarters, it got to that point on who was going to win, for us, the home ground was able to help us out and we were able to run the footy," Scoble said, "We had a lot of players that had to play role footy (specific roles), that's what it was all about for us."

"We came out after half-time and those same players had to play the same role and we started to take control of the game, when you play sides like that (Macedon, in the top six), you have to play four quarters, we just had to stick to the task and momentum went our way which was great."

Young midfielder, Matt Panuccio, played a vital part in the win and was one of the keys to the fight back.

"It was a good game, it sets us up for the next four weeks, we had good confidence and it was our first four quarter effort this year and we now know we can beat the best teams in the competition if we play a full four quarters," Panuccio said.

Coaching the Critical Ingredient

One of AFL Victoria's most important objectives is to ensure our participants enjoy the best possible environment to play Australian football.

The role of the coach is critical to creating a safe, inclusive and positive environment, especially at junior level.

The ability of a coach to encourage their players to reach their potential plays a huge role in their development, and doing this effectively helps ensure they eventually transition into openage football.

To support those who take charge every weekend out in the community, AFL Victoria offers coaching courses designed for different levels of football, from NAB AFL Auskick right through to senior community and state league competitions.

The courses are conducted regionally to ensure that all coaches, regardless of where the live, have the opportunity to attend.

We are pleased to see that the vast majority of coaches in Victoria are now accredited after completing one of our Level 1 courses.

The courses are typically one-day or two-day workshops that focus on the fundamentals of coaching and arm individuals with the knowledge and tools needed to develop players at a specific age level.

Coaches throughout the talent pathway can also complete level 2 and level

3 courses to enhance their skills and coaching credentials.

Over the past 18 months, AFL Victoria has strived to increase the number of female coaches in our game and break down barriers that stop them from pursuing coaching opportunities.

While it is important to provide a pathway for talented female coaches, we also need to focus on ensuring women feel comfortable about taking their first steps towards coaching at underage level.

To achieve this goal, AFL Victoria has created the Level O Coaching Course, which is designed specifically for women who are keen to learn about the basics of football so they can contribute in a greater capacity at NAB AFL Auskick clinics or junior football.

The courses have proved incredibly popular and pleasingly this led to our first ever Female Specific Level 1 Coaching Course last weekend.

Last week we also welcomed more than 80 Youth Girls footballers to Ikon Park to complete a Level 1 coaching course.

The girls' strong appetite for coaching is incredibly pleasing to see and we look forward to the day when they take charge of their own teams and inspire both boys and girls to play Australian football.

We hope all coaches, regardless of what level of the game they are involved in, understand how important their role is in helping football remain the sport of choice for all Victorians.

WESTERN WATER NETBALL WRAP

Riddell came out on top in the battle between ladder leaders of the Riddell District Netball League on Saturday.

The Bombers and Macedon both entered the match undefeated, having won all their games by at least five goals.

But the Bombers' 49-44 result wasn't a convincing win as, for much of the first three quarters, the Cats controlled the game.

Under pressure to hold strong in defence, the Bombers' Danni Davidson made several timely intercepts.

This time, the Bombers pressed on to take, and hold, the lead.

While the Cats fought back, they couldn't match it in the closing stages.

Bombers' coach Lauren Close said the match was what she expected.

"We definitely turned up today knowing it would be tough until the last quarter, and it turned out to be.

"I don't think you can ever be confident against Macedon.

"Bec (Colwell) coming back has been a massive addition to their team - it was never going to be over until the final siren."

Close said her side was still working out its best line-up. The move of Davidson to goalkeeper and Bridget Aughton to goal defence proved to be vital moves in the second quarter.

"We needed a bit more movement around her, as Elyce (Carlyle) was getting stuck on the body a little bit, and Danni is good aerially and a good voice down there, too.

"We have a few new players, It's about trying to work out what works best, especially as we won't meet them again until finals.

"It's not our full team; we are going to get better."

Close, who made a comeback from a knee reconstruction against Rockbank, said she was about four weeks away from returning to the court full-time.

In other games, Rupertswood, minus captain Tess Abbott, smashed Kilmore, 104–10, while Lancefield defeated Melton Centrals, 44–33, and Romsey defeated Wallon, 62–47.

Rupertswood v Macedon

Rupertswood is fresh off a 190 point mauling of Kilmore at the Shark Tank n their most impressive performance of the season to date. Macedon started strongly against the Bombers before fading in the second half to succumb to a 24 point loss.

The Sharks were polished and confident against a seriously undermanned Kilmore. Leigh Brennan was in sublime form with eight goals and he was well supported by the cunning Cam McRorie who kicked six goals in the bye weekend of the TAC Cup. Berry and Muir teamed up well to play some great football while Jorden Braddy worked hard in the ruck and used the ball well around the ground. He has really come of age in recent weeks and will feature prominently in this game. The Sharks had seven multiple goal kickers against the Blues and 10 overall. Macedon led by 10 points early in the third term against Riddell before handing over momentum and falling behind on the scoreboard. They played confident and daring football that all started with Clint Burgess and Teghan Henderson doing as they pleased in the backline. Match-ups went against them in the second half and that's where the Bombers snuck back into the game. Riddell is 1-2 against teams in the top six this year and played their best football to defect Macedon last week. 

SENIOR UMPIRES' CORNER

One element of umpiring that I gloat about to anyone that will listen is the access that community umpiring aroups have to the AFL Umpiring department. To have elite and professional umpires, and their coaches, available to attend training at a local suburban football ground is a wonderful resource and can only enhance recruitment and retention of umpires.

This year the Riddell Umpires have been fortunate enough to have three visits so far from the AFL Umpiring department. Just prior to round 1, 1st year AFL field umpire, Jack Edwards, worked with our development squad to educate them on the hard work and commitment it takes to make the AFL. Jack also addressed our senior umpires about his journey from community football to the top level.

Like most umpiring groups around the country, we took part in Community Umpiring weekend, with a visit from 4 current AFL umpires who took skill drills and spoke to our group about what happens on match day and dealing with the pressure of AFL football.

Up next a visit from AFL Umpires Head Coach, Hayden Kennedy. Hayden's address to over 100 umpires was on what makes Umpiring Success. He focused on five main areas; Free Kick Selection, Management of the Game, Skills, Communication and Bouncing. What impressed our group was Hayden's ability to relate what is happening at the top level down to local football. Umpires could

take away some elements to work on in their game the following weekend. Using video examples and some auestion and answer, Hayden was honest about where the game is heading and the role umpires play.

Like many players look up to their AFL idols, the same can easily be said for umpires. On all three occasions Riddell Umpires asked for further advice from their AFL counterparts, some hints and tips along with the odd photo as well. These visits are a vital component in the growth of umpiring across the country and we would like to thank the AFL umpiring department for their ongoing support of community umpiring.

WESTERN WATER NETBALL REPORT

This article by James Maasdorp is a reporter and producer for ABC Grandstand Sport titled *Women's sport is a seriously untapped market* looks at the recent success of women's sports teams and disproving the myth that women's sport is inferior to men's and highlighting the growing demand for more media coverage. We know that our sport is fantastic, but for all women's sport to be acknowledged is fantastic.

The myth that there's no interest in women's sport is crumbling fast in the wake of the Matildas' World Cup run and the exceptional trans-Tasman netball grand final.

They're the talk of the town, and rightly so: the Matildas' win over Brazil in the FIFA Women's World Cup was Australia's first ever win in the knockout stage of either the men's or women's global competition.

Just a day earlier, the trans-Tasman netball championship decider wowed pay-TV audiences as the Queensland Firebirds scored five straight goals at the death to snatch a 57-56 win over the NSW Swifts in Brisbane.

All the while, the internal metrics measuring eyeballs on stories at ABC News Online told its own story: the audience was furiously clicking on women's sport stories, and the appetite for them looks a long way from being sated.

Grandstand's article for the Matildas' win over Brazil was the most popular for June 22 by a long shot, exceeding Jordan Spieth's US Open win and a host of the ABC's more bread-and-butter political stories.

The netball grand final caught fire on social media in what was unanimously lauded as a scintillating, exciting contest, to the extent that "Firebirds" was trending nationally in Australia's twittersphere.

More and more, this is disproving the old myth that women's team sport is inferior to men's and, as a result, proving that there is significantly more demand for the greater media coverage of the women's game.

The myth that there's no interest in women's sport is crumbling fast, and while the nay-sayers may be circling the wagons, questions of both the quality of play and the sport's overall product are rapidly being answered.

The fierce intensity of the netball grand final and Katrina Gorry's awesome through-ball to set up Australia's winner against Brazil have showcased the quality on offer in netball and women's football.

But there are other aspects to the package, perhaps even a comparative advantage, that differentiates the women's game from the men. The sportsmanship on display from the defeated NSW Swifts players in the wake of the Firebirds win, particularly from MVP Sharni Layton, was lauded far and wide across social media.

The FIFA Women's World Cup has also been praised for having significantly less gamesmanship, preening and mean-spiritedness than modern men's football at the top level.

In some ways, the fact that many of these sportswomen have to balance their exceptional on-field abilities with full-time occupations or study is a blessing, giving us well-rounded, relatable individuals who must truly cherish the adoration they receive from the crowd.

But what's sauce for the goose is sauce for the gander. The holy grail, for equality's sake, must be professionalisation of women's team sport. That will not happen overnight. It will take years, perhaps even several generations, of successive women's competitions to establish, in the same way men's modern sport evolved in the late 19th and early 20th century.

What cannot be argued any longer, however, is that the quality of women's sport still has some way to catch up to men.

Yes, men will for the most part be taller, stronger and quicker than women in overall benchmarks, but if this were the barometer for quality in all sport, there would never have been a market for women's tennis, surfing or practically any Olympic event.

Women's sport may be physically different to the men's code, but it is no less strategic or passionate. In time, given the opportunity, it too can be equally storied and develop its own history.

Fox Sports must be credited for the excellent product it has delivered in its broadcasting of the trans-Tasman netball championship. The netball has proved it can stand on its own two feet, but now serious questions should be asked as how to better foster other women's team sports.

The AFL has already said it is pushing for a national women's league to commence in 2017, with the Western Bulldogs and Melbourne Demons' women's teams already featuring this season at the MCG, prior to the men's team fixtures.

It will be a more difficult sell for the round ball game, with the quality of the pitch (set to host two back-to-back games) held in such high regard by players and groundskeepers, and bad weather could further complicate the argument on the day.

But the conversation remains critical for football. With the women's game enjoying such high participation rates and greater coverage in Australia's media, some kind of arrangement needs to be found between stakeholders to get more eyes on the women's game to tap in to the Matilidas' success.

Playing and watching sport is meant for everyone. The joy (and despair) felt watching our top footballers and netballers has been widespread, crossing the gender divide.

Now it's time for the media to start putting the foundations in place for the eventual equality in news representation of women's sport.


