





Plenty of pathway options

Managing the many different elements of the talent pathway is one of AFL Victoria's most important objectives.

On the surface the pathway might appear simple, with so many stars of the game beginning their journey at NAB Auskick, then making their mark with a junior football club before taking the final step in the TAC Cup and our Vic Country and Vic Metro Academies.

But through this pathway there are a number of systems in place to ensure young players receive the right development both on and off-field, and that boys and girls can find different avenues to reach their potential, regardless of what age they are when introduced to Australian football.

Our programs must also provide an environment that allows junior footballers to prosper regardless of their background, while understanding that not all players develop at the same stage of the pathway.

Our ultimate aim is to see Victoria's most talented footballers reach the highest level of football they can, whether that be the AFL, the Peter Jackson VFL or metropolitan or country community competitions.

The 19-year-old player provision in the TAC Cup and the 23rd player rule in the VFL are examples of how AFL Victoria ensures the pathway is adaptable to different circumstances.

Collingwood rising star Tom Langdon was a product of the 19-year-old rule which allows TAC Cup regions to retain a player who would normally be too old for the U18 competition.

Players may benefit from an extra year of development for various reasons, such as a serious injury or the fact they may be a latecomer to the sport.

The 23rd player rule in the VFL gives clubs another tool to help players develop, with sides able to include an extra player and allow them to test themselves at that level without the pressure that may be associated with being picked in the 22-man team.

Often we see players who remain in the TAC Cup as a 19-year-old also enjoy a chance to play as a 23rd player in the VFL through the alignment between TAC Cup regions and VFL clubs.

This allows recruiters to get a good gauge on the level of the player's development and also gives the player a chance to get a taste of senior football.

Last year Murray Bushrangers pair Nathan Drummond and Dan Howe both spent time with Richmond in the VFL, providing these players with an opportunity to experience training and playing at the next level against VFL and AFL-listed players. Both found themselves on AFL lists later in the year with Richmond and Hawthorn respectively.

The alignment between the VFL clubs and TAC Cup regions also encourages all players who miss out on being selected in the NAB AFL Draft to continue to play at the highest level of football possible.

Often this is at state league level alongside former teammates who are further developing their game in the VFL while on AFL lists.

Young Dogs, plenty of tricks

First-year Footscray coach Ashley Hansen has taken the reins of a dynamic, young premiership-winning team that continues to roll quality AFL and VFL-listed talent off its development line.

So what's in the water down at VU Whitten Oval?

"There's no secret – and if there was, I probably wouldn't be telling," Hansen laughs.

"I think we've brought in some really good kids with a really good attitude to learning and working hard, which is a fundamental of becoming a better player.

"It's certainly been exciting to work with the current crop we've got."

AFL observers would be familiar with young Bulldogs such as Mitch Honeychurch, Lin Jong, Jason Johannisen, Ayce Cordy, Jack Redpath and Michael Talia, who have gone on to play regular football at the elite level in 2015 after featuring in Footscray's Grand Final triumph over the Box Hill Hawks last September.

But as those players begin to cement themselves in the Western Bulldogs line-up, lesser-known VFL-listed players are emerging to take their place.

One of those Bulldog pups defied his own expectations to earn a spot in that 2014 flag-winning team in just his first season of senior football. Will Hayes has continued his rapid rise this season, playing every match except one and being named Footscray's best player in wins against the Northern Blues in Round 12 and Geelong in Round 14.

Hansen – an ex-West Coast premiership forward – was glowing in his praise of the 20-year-old's development since graduating from the Sandringham Dragons TAC Cup program in 2013.

"Will's just a great young man," Hansen said.

"His application to his training, diligence to want to learn and appetite to do everything he can to be the best player he can has just been fantastic.

"I love working with him – he's certainly enjoyable to coach and he's getting the best out of himself at the moment."

The former Melbourne Grammar boy booted important bags of four and three goals to help sink Northern and Geelong respectively, as Hansen continues to develop 180cm Hayes as a dangerous forward.

"His game in regards to the defensive side and

contested side is really starting to complement his offensive ability, which is probably his natural tendency," Hansen said.

"He's an exciting young player and one we've got high hopes for."

Hayes himself said he was reaping the rewards of developing his craft with Footscray forwards coach Chad Jones.

"One of the big things I've been working on over the past month is my contested ground balls, which have significantly improved," Hayes said.

"I've been working with Chad after training most nights, just doing a few extra ground balls and working on my cleanness below my knees.

"It gives you more confidence to back yourself in when you're cleaner and gives you more time on the field; I've been lucky in that respect (recently)."

Hayes said he was also physically bigger this season compared to 2014 and "more mentally prepared for the contest".

It has seen him flourish alongside fellow VFL-listed talents such as 24-year-old Michael Fogarty and 20-year-old Mitch Jensen, who have also gone on to play regular senior football after featuring in Footscray's premiership team last year.

To those names, you can add impressive youngsters Nick Jamieson, Meyrick Buchanan, Tom Sharp, Darcy Fort and Liam Nash, who have all made an impact at the Kennel this season.

Clearly the guiding voices of Hansen and Development Coach Stewart Edge, as well as senior players such as Jordan Russell, Mark Austin and Brent Prismall, are doing something right.

Hayes said their influence provided the right environment to help him chase his dream of eventually making an AFL list.

"They all seek to develop you as full players – to develop every aspect of your game defensively and offensively – and they put a lot of time into each individual player on the list," Hayes said.

"(Ash Hansen) is really easy to approach and always gives you positive and constructive feedback, and always leaves you in a good mental space.

"He always encourages the boys to seek out how to get better and to always be looking to improve ourselves."

Hansen, who appears to have made a seamless

transition from Development Coach to taking over from Chris Maple as Head Coach, said the club's focus on development was a key to its success.

"We have a new coach at AFL level, Luke Beveridge, who's come out of a successful development program himself (at Hawthorn) and seen how Box Hill have had success, so he's been really supportive of our VFL team," Hansen said.

"It might sound clichéd, but when you work with players on a day-to-day basis, you see what they're capable of – sometimes that's not consistent (with what you see on-field), but you know you've seen growth during the week.

"When you start to see that, you know it's probably going to come out in games on a more regular basis and when they start to string contests, quarters and matches together, we're looking at a very good side."

With the club's AFL and VFL teams both in the thick of finals conversations, that development line out west will only be picking up speed.

Skinner gets creative

Suffering a serious knee injury in your draft year is certainly not ideal, but Gippsland Power key-position player Sam Skinner is finding several ways to keep himself positive during his recovery.

The 18-year-old has been nurturing his creative side as he shifts his focus away from the ACL he ruptured at the end of May while playing for Vic Country at the NAB AFL U18 Championships.

Skinner thought the weird feeling in his leg "couldn't be too bad" when he went down in the Round 2 match against WA in Perth, initially getting back up and jogging around on it.

But the news soon came that the AFL Academy member was to miss the rest of the season and would have a lot more time to pursue his interests in music and art.

"I like to belt out a tune here and there," Skinner said.

"I just sit around at home and play a bit of guitar and sing a little bit; I do a bit of drawing as well – I think it helps with how my recovery's going.

"Obviously now I don't have football, you've got to have something else; you've got to have that thing to help keep you positive off the football field.

"That's why I'm lucky I can do the music and a bit of drawing."

There are tentative plans for an acoustic trio to begin playing small gigs in the Gippsland area, but any potential music career would happily be put on hold to have a chance of playing football at the elite level.

Skinner hopes to be jogging on the knee in a few weeks' time, but won't be able to complete the physical testing at October's AFL Draft Combine, for which he was announced as an invitee this week.


However, his knowledge of the game is sure to improve despite his absence from the field, with Skinner spending time in the Gippsland coaches' box on game days.

"Up there, it's a lot different," he said.

"I enjoy it; I like getting up there, helping (head coach Leigh Brown) out and looking at the vision.

"Now I understand why there are so many coaches, because it's too hard for the one coach to watch everything... Leigh handles that really well, so it's good just watching how he goes about it."

On the field, Skinner – a self-confessed tough judge of himself – said his form was "between average and good" before being injured.



At 197cm, he's been played down back, up forward and in the ruck at times over the past three seasons, but thinks he feels most comfortable in a key defensive post.

It's the position in which he won Vic Country's MVP award at the 2013 U16 Championships, in a team that featured likely high picks at the 2015 AFL Draft Jacob Weitering, Josh Schache, Darcy Parish, Rhys Mathieson and Darcy Tucker.

Dandenong Stingray Weitering said if anyone in this year's Vic Country crop could handle an ACL injury in the most positive manner possible, it was Skinner.

"For the first two rounds (of the U18 Championships), he was the life of the party, really," Weitering said.

"It was a big loss, him going down with his ACL in WA.

"If there's anyone who can deal with that sort of injury in the team, it's Sammy Skinner – he has a lot of resilience and confidence in himself."

Wilkinson's work continues

Northern Blues vice-captain Joel Wilkinson may have left the Peter Jackson VFL playing arena, but he isn't leaving the football industry entirely.

As the football world prepares to celebrate Multicultural Round next weekend, the recently retired 23-year-old is continuing to work with AFL Victoria on the development of its Community Club Cultural Education program in his role as a VFL Multicultural Ambassador.

Wilkinson has Nigerian heritage through his father and European heritage through his mother, and is hoping to promote and increase awareness of different cultural identities within Australian football by sharing his experiences with clubs at all levels.

The former Gold Coast Suns player experienced racial vilification during his three-year, 26-game AFL career and is utilising his ambassadorship to educate others in the game on the importance of accepting diversity.

"It's just been about continually promoting cultural identity within the sport when the opportunities have arrived," Wilkinson said.

"It's an opportunity to promote experiences I've had in the AFL to then open up awareness and really challenge the current conditions, and work on areas that need improvement."

Wilkinson challenged the line of thought that multicultural players with a relatively small amount of football experience behind them made it to the elite level because of their inherent athletic gifts.

In an entry to the sport Wilkinson described as "unorthodox", the Gold Coast native didn't start playing Australian football until he was 17, quickly rising through the elite underage ranks in Queensland to be taken by the Suns with a zone selection in 2010.

He acknowledged his natural attributes helped him to initially pick up the new game, just like he'll be hoping they help him now as he turns his focus to playing American football.

Indeed, athleticism is in his genes – his parents were also talented athletes in sports as diverse as soccer, rugby union, athletics and surf lifesaving.

But Wilkinson said like anyone striving to make it to the elite level of their sport, simple hard work was the key for him when he set out to reach the AFL.

"I believe I worked very hard in those early times to try and fast-track my progression," Wilkinson said.

"Have I been blessed with certain athleticism? Sure, but to get to the AFL, I felt I worked my way into earning that spot – I remember a lot of extra training I was doing.

"I'm sure that to start playing (Australian football), it was my athleticism (that helped), but to get drafted, I felt I showed more than just athleticism." An appetite for hard work is a trait Wilkinson said was central to all multicultural players trying to crack the AFL.

It's a necessary quality for the increasing numbers of people from diverse cultural backgrounds who come to the game late and are behind the eight-ball in terms of experience from the start.

Wilkinson is still learning about his own cultural background – something that makes him unique in the current football environment.

But in his role as a VFL Multicultural Ambassador, he's also aiming to raise awareness about what makes the people who play football the same.

Top eight settled?

With five rounds to play in the Peter Jackson VFL home-and-away season, have the eight teams bound for finals action already been settled?

After an upset 13-point victory over the Box Hill Hawks on Sunday, eighthplaced Werribee moved two wins clear of Port Melbourne in ninth, with the injury-plagued Borough soundly beaten by Williamstown.

The Tigers still have a bye to come in Round 18, but Port is well behind them on percentage and has big games against current top-eight teams Sandringham, Footscray and Collingwood to come, as well as a meeting this week with the giant-killing Coburg outfit which defeated Footscray on Saturday.

Werribee's win against Box Hill was vital, as the club must still negotiate tough encounters with the Casey Scorpions, Essendon, Williamstown and Footscray in its final four matches.

In an even year, Footscray and the Casey Scorpions are other eight-win teams potentially in danger of falling out of the top eight, but Werribee and Port Melbourne might just be the ones fighting the defining battle in the race to make it to September.

Blue Bransgrove out for season

A serious hamstring injury has ended the season of Northern Blues captain Brent Bransgrove.

The 27-year-old suffered the blow early in Northern's 47-point loss to the Casey Scorpions at Ikon Park in Round 14.

Bransgrove had played every match of the season until that point after niggling injuries restricted him to just 22 senior games across 2013 and 2014.

The 170cm midfielder out of Whittlesea and the Northern Knights has captained the Blues for four seasons now (two as co-captain with Andre Gianfagna in 2012 and 2013) and played 95 senior games with the club.

Another experienced Blue, Kieran McGuinness, is also out of the team at the moment due to a shoulder injury sustained in Northern's Round 13 loss to Richmond.

Potential seasondefiners

Matches in Round 16 could have a huge bearing on positioning within the Peter Jackson VFL top four and top eight ahead of September's Legendairy finals series.

Three games on a blockbuster Sunday will pit current top-eight teams against one another.

At VU Whitten Oval in the Channel 7 match of the round, Footscray (8-5) takes on Essendon (9-4) for a spot in the top four.

The Bulldogs have a strong percentage, but a loss to the Bombers combined with a Port Melbourne win over Coburg will see the reigning premiers only one game ahead of ninth position. Channel 7's live broadcast will begin at 11.30am on Sunday.

The Casey Scorpions (8-5) and Werribee (8-6) will face off in an equally important encounter at Casey Fields with both clubs anchored in the bottom half of the top eight, while Collingwood (9-4) will test itself against ladder-leading Williamstown (10-3) at Burbank Oval.





The Geelong Falcons must be getting sick of that hollow feeling when the final siren sounds but there's no winner.

The draw is usually a rare occurrence in Australian football, but the TAC Cup has seen four of them already in 2015, with the Falcons unbelievably involved in three draws in the last five rounds.

After ties with Tasmania in Round 10 and Sandringham in Round 12, Geelong split the points with the Eastern Ranges at Box Hill City Oval on Saturday.

The Falcons had to rally from 21 points down at three-quarter time to draw level at game's end in a clash that kept both teams even on premiership points, with the Ranges only in fourth position on percentage.

The Oakleigh Chargers had a chance to take that spot in the top four outright against the Calder Cannons at Warrawee Park, but fell short by 20 points.

It was a crucial win for the Cannons, who moved one game clear of their only rival for a place in the top eight, the Sandringham Dragons.

The ninth-placed Dragons gave up a six-point lead at the final change to go down to the NSW/ ACT Rams by 12 points at Trevor Barker Beach Oval and have some work to do to make the finals, with matches against top-eight teams Dandenong, Gippsland and Eastern to come.

The Rams farewelled the TAC Cup in 2015 with their fifth win from seven matches, while Queensland also said goodbye for the year with a record of 2-3 after losing to the North Ballarat Rebels by 47 points at Eureka Stadium.

In Round 14's other matches:

- The Murray Bushrangers overcame a fourpoint three-quarter-time deficit to defeat an inaccurate Gippsland Power by 10 points at Norm Minns Oval and maintain third place on the ladder;
- The Bendigo Pioneers notched their second win of the season by five points in a tight struggle with fellow one-win team the Western Jets at Epsom Huntly Reserve; and
- The Dandenong Stingrays held second spot with an 18-point victory over the Northern Knights at Preston City Oval.



The aerial provess of a couple of Murray towers at each end of the ground proved a big difference in the Bushrangers' defeat of the Gippsland Power. Nick Coughlan took the most marks of any TAC Cup player in Round 14 with 12 grabs down back, while Josh Schache took nine up forward to help him record a five-goal haul.

In a battle between two teams desperate to move off one win for the season, Bendigo Pioneer Thomas Cole showed plenty of individual desperation against the Western

Jets on Saturday. Cole had a massive 20 contested possessions in the tight struggle, while Western's Jaycob Hickey wasn't to be outdone in a losing cause, also racking up 20.



Oakleigh Charger Tom Phillips may have scorched the stats sheet with 44 disposals, but it wasn't enough to get his team over the line against the Calder Cannons. Phillips' 32

kicks was a round-high, but victorious Calder midfielder Nick O'Kearney's tally of 24 wasn't far behind.

Drawn conclusions

The Geelong Falcons had played 455 games in club history for only two drawn results before Round 10 of the 2015 TAC Cup season.

But in the last five rounds, Geelong has unbelievably added another three draws to that tally, tying with Tasmania in Round 10, the Sandringham Dragons in Round 12 and the Eastern Ranges on Saturday in Round 14.

In fact, the Falcons have almost added another couple of draws this year to their all-time tally of five, just getting over the line with a two-point win against the North Ballarat Rebels in Round 2 and a one-point triumph over the Gippsland Power in Round 4.

Incidentally, the weekend's tie was the first in Eastern's history, which stretches back to the TAC Cup's inaugural year in 1992.

So, which team has been involved in the most draws since the competition's inception?

Well, that dubious honour goes to the Calder Cannons and Northern Knights, which have both been involved in six draws.

Northern's tally includes three draws with Sandringham, one of only two sets of clubs to have split the points on more than one occasion in the competition's history, with the other set being Gippsland and the Oakleigh Chargers on two occasions.

Draft Combine invitees

The Dandenong Stingrays boasted the most Combine invitees with eight – headlined by defensive duo Jacob Weitering and Kieran Collins – while the Oakleigh Chargers have six potential draftees invited to take part in the October 8-11 Combine.

Lever launches


Former Vic Metro captain Jake Lever has been nominated for the NAB Rising Star award after a stellar performance in defence for Adelaide against the Gold Coast Suns at Adelaide Oval on Saturday.


The 19-year-old had 24 disposals at 92 per cent efficiency, took 10 marks and proved a constant thorn in Gold Coast's side as it took the ball forward, recording seven rebound-50s in the Crows' 45-point win.

An ex-Calder Cannon, Lever was selected with pick no.14 at the 2014 NAB AFL Draft and has played seven senior matches for Adelaide since making his debut in Round 6.

He is averaging 16.1 disposals and 6.3 marks per game at AFL level, and is ranked first among players eligible for the Rising Star in rebound-50s per game.

The Romsey junior captained Vic Metro in the 2013 NAB AFL U18 Championships before injuring his ACL the following pre-season and subsequently missing the 2014 football year.





Several former Peter Jackson VFL players featured in one of the most anticipated AFL matches between Victorian clubs this season, the blockbuster between Richmond and Hawthorn at the MCG on Friday night.

The most recent graduate is ex-Northern Blues and Williamstown player Kane Lambert, who had played five consecutive matches for Richmond prior to this round, starring most recently in the Tigers' four-point loss to Fremantle last Saturday with 22 disposals, eight clearances, six tackles and four inside-50s.

The 23-year-old was taken by the Tigers with pick no.46 at last year's AFL Rookie Draft and after injuring his shoulder on debut in Round 2, Lambert has set about establishing himself in the fifth-placed Richmond outfit in recent weeks.

Based on the previous round's teams, Lambert was likely to be joined in Friday's blockbuster by four other VFL graduates: Richmond teammate Sam Lloyd (ex-Frankston) and Hawthorn stars Sam Mitchell (Box Hill Hawks), Josh Gibson (Port Melbourne) and Isaac Smith (North Ballarat).

Waite over for game 200

Former Murray Bushranger Jarrad Waite will play his 200th AFL game when his new team North Melbourne meets his original club Carlton at Etihad Stadium on Saturday night.

The 32-year-old was taken with pick no.46 in the 2001 AFL Draft as a father-son selection, with his father Vin Waite a dual Blues premiership player in the 1970s.

The 194cm Benalla product was used as both a key forward and key defender during his time with Carlton and has played as a marking target inside 50 for the Kangaroos since crossing to Arden Street for the 2015 season.

He has booted 275 career goals, often demonstrating his ability to turn matches through his impact on the scoreboard.
