

Obituary

Philip Walsh

Club identity Bill Feely recounts his personal memories of his friend the late Phil Walsh.

Phil Walsh's journey in football began with St Mary's Junior Football Club's Under 13 team under the coaching of Father Peter Murphy as a skinny but tenacious little kid wrapped in a green and gold jumper. On frosty mornings, or in pouring rain, playing at venues such as Pedrina Park, the Friendlies Oval, Mitchell Park or Monivae, 'Murph' exhorted us all to "never give in" and "inspire yourself to get the best out of your ability" I believe that Phil adhered to these mantras all through his career, he pushed himself to get the most out of whatever ability life had given him. I remember his earl kicking style was the 'slam banger' - a far cry from the raking left foot kick that he became. Having kick to kick at half-time at Melville Oval, watching Hamilton or Imps playing, followed by a feed of fish & chips, life didn't get any better! Phil stayed with St. Marys through to the Under 17s; our coach in that final grade was 'Bluey' Donne who was coincidently Josh Kearney's Grandfather and Phil's next door neighbour. Later when the Hamilton Junior Football League was disbanded, Phil moved to the Mininera League, along with many of the young lads that went on to play with Hamilton and Imperials, Mick Soulsby, Wayne Fletcher, Glen Wilson, Kevin Peters, Peter Kearney, Simon McDonald, Shane Taylor, Brian Guy, Gary Nield, Peter Clarke Steven Donne, Paul Russell, Peter Ross, and Alan Sutherland. Walshy's path to the (then) VFL took a few twists and turns. Attending Ballarat Teachers College he studied Physical Education, becoming fixated with sports science. By then Phil had grown 4 or 5 inches; and leaving no stone unturned, took to the Gym to become as fit and strong as he possibly could. While at Uni. He played with Moonambel, in the old Lexton Plains League then later Redan in the BFL where he thrived under the coaching of former VFL player and Coach John Northey. He might have played interleague, but the BFL was at that time full of ex and future VFL stars. Phil's first teaching appointment took him to Portland. That enabled a return to Hamilton and the opportunity to play with the Magpies, a great thrill, as it was his Dad's old club. After a stellar season, Phil accepted an offer from Zone Manager Paul Cranage to join Collingwood, winning the VFL's Best first year Player. That launched Phil's wonderful career that spanned 32 years and involvement with seven clubs, culminating in his final appointment as coach of the Adelaide Football Club. And from that determined young boy through to the proud but humble man he became, Phil never got 'ahead of himself' - he was always just 'Walshy'

I am so proud to have had the pleasure of travelling part of that journey with my mate - Vale Phil Walsh
