## Dean Jenkinson

Role model for all young Footballers

Unfortunately we are in the midst of an era when many young men are turning their backs on football and seem to find it hard to muster the time, energy or willingness to commit to an extended playing career. It is in the context of this current malaise that the name Dean Jenkinson always springs to mind. In a career that has lasted more than thirty years Dean, as player, coach, selector and runner has been a fine example of what can be achieved with the right attitude, strength of mind and determination to, not just succeed, but persist when things are at their most difficult. One can only hope that young footballers of this generation can take some inspiration from Dean's story. While Dean 'Jumbo' Jenkinson, has experienced plenty of team and personal triumphs, it is the many times, that he has obligingly put his, sometimes injured body on the line and fronted up, for the likes of struggling reserves teams, where helping the team out is the key motivation.



### Dean Andrew Jenkinson's Impressive Career

- 1982 Commenced with Glenthompson in the under 15s – including two Best & Fairests
- 1985 First year of senior football, where he was part of the Premiership side and also was runner in club voting – played through to 1987
- 1988 – 1990 played with the Hamilton Imperial Football Club
- 1991-1992 Played two seasons (26 Games) with Central Districts in SANFL
- 1993 Returned to Imperials and played in the senior Premiership. Was runner up the in Western Border Medal Count and was an interleague and Team of the Year representative.
- 1994 Played with in a premiership at Maroochydore in the Brisbane Football League, finished third in both Club and League Best & Fairest also Queensland Country Football Interleague representative
- 1995 Returned to Victoria as Assistant Coach of Heywood in the WBFL, where he was the League and Club Best & Fairest Medal winner, Team of the Year, Interleague representative, Victorian Footballer of the Year.
- 1996 Continued on as Heywood Assistant Coach, third in the WBFL Medal and Captain of the Interleague Team
- 1997 Appointed Coach of Hamilton Imperials, who were Grand Finalists – again League representative.
- 2001 and 2002 Coach of Pt. Fairy in the Hampden FNL and League Representative
- 2003 to 2007 Coach and player at Glenthompson/ Glenthompson Dunkeld Rams, Best & Fairest in 2003 and 2006, Runner up in 2004 and 2007
- 2008 to 2012 Hamilton Imperials
- 2010 Senior Runner up in Best & Fairest Count
- 2012 Selector and Reserves Best & Fairest Winner
- 2008 to Current date Western Border Schoolboys involvement
- 2013 Played in the newly formed Kangaroos Reserves team
- 2015 Ballarat Rebels (TAC) Under 16s Line Coach
- Dean has played more than 500 senior games
