I asked Rhianne and Aly Smead to change how they were playing defence and our attack end to steady and treasure possession and not force the ball into the shooting circle and lift our all over court defence.

To the girls credit they started doing exactly what I asked and things started to turn. We got some great touches and intercepts in defence and our feeding into the circle improved along with our shooting. We started to peg back the lead and ended up taking a one goal lead into half time.

The third quarter was very close and basically went goal for goal. Both teams defence ends were working overtime and we were not able to push the lead out by much at all. We took a 2 goal lead into the last quarter. Again this was a very tight quarter. Reason for coming to Hamilton - I was offered the position of gap student at Hamilton and Alexandra College, dividing my time between Junior and Senior campus, helping with everything from year 1 spelling, year 12 PE, coaching under 17 and senior Hockey teams. Cricket team mate Cam Penny invited me to come down to training at the Kangaroos - so here I am! Favourite memories, my first in the practice match at Ararat, first goal on ANZAC Day, and the win at Terang - what a comeback.

In AFL I follow the Geelong Cats - favourite player Jed Bews.

On June 23rd I return to Oxford Brookes University to study economics, politics and International relations; and watch England retain the Ashes!!

I can't thank Hammer (Hamish Waldron) and Jon Manson, enough for all their advice and guidance, also the rest of the reserves boys for pointing me in the right direction.
