

INTRODUCING... THE YALE UNIVERSITY BULLDOGS

Based in New Haven, Connecticut, Yale University is a private institution of higher education known for its academic excellence, selectivity in admissions and social elitism – having graduated 5 U.S Presidents, 19 Supreme Court Judges, 13 Billionaires, countless members of Congress and Rhodes Scholars.

Having been established in October 1701, Yale is the 3rd oldest University in the United States.

The Basketball program is well regarded, and the team are known as the Yale University Bulldogs which compete in the Ivy League – a collection of 8 private Universities who are generally regarded as the most prestigious and highest ranked worldwide.

The Bulldogs have won 6 National Championships, dating back to the early 1900s, and 5 Division 1 Ivy League Championships - including 2015 (tied with Harvard).

Yale's coach is 51-year-old James Jones, who has spent 16 seasons with the team to date, has coached to at 57% win rate and has accumulated the 3rd highest wins in Ivy League history. Earlier this year, Jones was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame. Under Coach Jones, the Bulldogs have assumed the identity of being a physically

tough outfit who pride themselves on rebounding the ball with reckless abandon at both ends of the floor. They want to get EVERY rebound and win their team more possessions.

Yale will be lead by the stellar play of Seniors Justin Sears and Jack Montague. 6'8 Sears was named the lvy League Player of the Year for 2015, averaged 14.7 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game last season and was a highlight reel waiting to happen.

Meanwhile, 6'1 Montague is an enigmatic guard, who is a sniper from long range – shooting nearly 44% from the 3pt line last season. Montague was also named captain of the Bulldogs for the coming season.

The Bulldogs play our Big V State Championship Men's team as part of a 10 day Australian tour of Melbourne and Sydney. Our upcoming trip to Australia will help us build upon the success we've enjoyed the last two seasons," said Head

Coach James Jones. "It will also give our younger players an opportunity to filter into our system with real game experience so when the time comes this season they will be ready for action."

While in Melbourne, the side will be playing tourist, including a training session with the Collingwood Football Club (Australian Rules), assist in conducting a basketball clinic with Helping Hoops, checking out the wildlife at Healesville Sanctuary, and an Australian Rules Football game between Hawthorn and Geelong at the famed Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG).

In Sydney, the Bulldogs are planning to visit some of their famed beaches, the Sydney Harbour Bridge and Opera House (courtesy of Pick-and-Roll).




