Pete's passion for the Burra began in the mid 90's when son Lindon started playing Junior Football & Cricket with Diggers Rest. He instantly became an active parent, involving himself with mentoring Lindon and his friends with their sport, and with his outgoing friendly personality, strong friendships were born both within the group of young boys and their parents.

In 2003 Lindon played his first game for the Diggers Rest Senior Football Netball Club under Coach Brian

Hayes. It was then that Pete also expanded his passion to a Senior Club level. Over the years he assisted in many different roles including Vice President. Most would remember him as a devoted Umpires Escort.

Pete never missed a game of Netball cheering on both his daughters Karrah and Teagan along with their team mates.

After games, Pete would always be found in the Burra's Club having a refreshing beer or two telling a story to a captivated crowd. He loved to tell a tale.

Pete's involvement with the Burra spread across the 12 months of the year with him becoming very involved with the Diggers Rest Bulla Village Cricket Club from the mid 90's. His involvement included a career as a Valuable Player netting him a total of 111 games, 2033 runs, 28 wickets, 60 catches and 1 stumping. Let's not forget the 9 ducks and his highest run score of 94 in his last game.



Not just a player, Pete contributed greatly to the success of the DRBVCC in recent years. Pete was awarded Life Membership in 2009 and served 6 seasons as President from 2009 – 2015.

Unwell at the time, Pete was named as 12th man in the 2014/2015 GDCA B Grade Grand Final Burra Premiership. Unfortunately Pete was in hospital during that Grand Final, however through current technology, was able to watch the Burra win live from his bed.

Pete easily made friends with everyone he met and was well known throughout the RDFNL and GDCA. He was a true representative that the BURRA is proud of.

Devoted and loving father to Lindon, Karrah & Teagan. Father in-law to Kerrie, Brett and Ryan. Poppy to Cooper and Charlotte. Best mate, mentor, father figure and friend to all that met him. Not only a great talker but a fantastic listener.

Pete was a passionate, devoted and hardworking Burra member.

He will be remembered as a legend amongst us, and may his spirit be with all of us and his legacy be passed down through many Burra generations.

MILE STONE: DYLAN 'JON' HANNAN 150 GAMES


This week our Club celebrates an important milestone when Dylan Hannan plays his 150th game for our great Club.
