# **PRESIDENTS REPORT (Football) 2015**

Having gone through a season of split venues for both training and game day, we were excited to think that this year would bring some normality back to the club, and with the bottom oval works to be completed over the off season as well as the club room development, things were looking great.

As the work in the off season began as normal with the planning of coaches appointments, team selections, registrations and planning ahead for the new season, we were seeing the date of the club room development being pushed further and further back from the initial planned October 2014 start date. When the New Year rolled over and the start of the works was still no-where in sight, we were forced to start planning for the worst case scenario, assuming that we wouldn't have use of the canteen as we required during the football season.

Again our teams started training at multiple venues as our use of the bottom oval during the pre-season was still on restrictions, and we were waiting for the official OK from council to move all teams back home.

In March we received word from council that the building works were to commence in April! Many discussions were had with council about how we could operate out of a venue with no canteen, and negotiations were made to ensure that we still had use of our office whilst the works were underway. Within a couple of weeks of being handed back the club, we had to make sure that everything was stowed away so that construction could commence. As an interim measure, a portable canteen was made available to the club to operate from, which in fact was no more than a ticket booth, that in itself created many issues for our canteen manager to work around, and also meant that we could only offer a restricted menu.

Midway through the season we lost the use of our office, this made the simplest things so much harder to execute, however a few weeks later when we were handed the office back, we were extremely pleased with the results, with so much more storage and a proper fitted out office, the prospect of what was to come with the rest of the development was looking very promising.

Our illustrious time keeper boxes, are finally taking shape and the majority of the hard work was taken on by myself, along with some committee members, and a few of our families offering their assistance, to keep the costs down to an absolute minimum. This great asset will make the job of time keeping so much more enjoyable, than it has been in the past.

Next year is already starting to look good, two functioning ovals, brand new industrial kitchen, bigger facilities and couple of timekeeper boxes to add to our renewed venue. Some exciting times ahead for the club and our members. There are still some other additional items that still need attention, these include the second set of light towers for the top oval, and new coaches boxes, which will ensure better safety of the players and allow teams training on the oval, better use of the whole ground. It would be a good idea to apply for the grant to get the digital scoreboards that we so desperately need at the venue moving forward as well.

The last few years has seen nearly \$1 Million dollars spent on our venue to ensure that it is a great place for our members to play football. A great achievement for all of those involved.

Despite the interrupted season experienced with the redevelopment of our venue, there was an air of excitement amongst the members and the committee, about what was

The committee is also continually reviewing and implementing new policies and procedures to ensure the clubs success in the years to come.

Our U17's this season were the first combined 16's and 17's team, bringing together two teams to play as one, a big change in how these teams were structured in the past. On the 4<sup>th</sup> of September we said farewell to our older age players as they now make the move across to senior footy. A great night was had by all the players and their parents. This team currently holds the record for the largest number of playing life members, being 12 in one team. I would like to congratulate all the boys who achieved such a monumental milestone, and wish all the boys the best of luck in their future endeavors in our great game.

I would like to thank all the hard working volunteers who have put countless hours into the respective playing groups, be it the coaches, the team managers, trainers, runners, and all the parents who gave up their time to do a little bit to ensure that our players took the field on game day, your contribution is much appreciated.

I would also like to thank the committee this year for their assistance in getting through a difficult time in our clubs development, and a special thank you to our committee members who are moving on this year and who have spent many years working hard to make the club the success that it is today.
