

# Exciting month ahead

## Welcome to a big month of finals football in the Peter Jackson VFL and TAC Cup.

It was a thrilling finale to the home-and-away season in both competitions, with the top four not being locked away until the final games on Sunday.

We thank Dairy Australia for their continued support, as they return as the naming rights partner to the VFL Legendairy Finals Series. Dairy Australia is a major partner of our Vic Country and Metro Academies and we appreciate their support of our AFL Victoria programs and competitions.

For the second year running, Footscray left it until the dying moments of its final game of the year to decide its opponent in week 1 of the VFL Legendairy finals. A late goal to Tom Boyd saw the Bulldogs defeat Werribee, securing the double chance and a qualifying final against the Box Hill Hawks.

In the TAC Cup, it was the weekend of upsets, with just three of the top eight teams recording a win in the final round. The Sandringham Dragons' win over the Eastern Ranges opened the door to the top four for the Geelong Falcons, with Andrew Allthorpe's side securing the double chance with a final-round win against the second-placed Dandenong Stingrays. The win completed an all-Country top four for only the third time in competition history, featuring the North Ballarat Rebels, Dandenong, Murray Bushrangers and Geelong.

During the final round a number of individual honours were decided.

Congratulations to back-to-back 'Frosty' Miller Medal winner Sam Grimley, who once again was forced to share the award – this year with not one but two players. In a quiet final round for all three eventual winners, two goals to Richmond's Liam McBean and singles to Port Melbourne's Jordan Lisle and Grimley saw the trio finish on 42 goals apiece. Despite an eight-year finals streak coming to an end for Port Melbourne, they were able to continue their recent run of goalkicking leaders, with Lisle the fifth Borough player in a row to top the table at the end of the home-and-away rounds.

In the TAC Cup, Blake Hardwick finished on top of the goalkicking ladder with 46 goals, facing no fear of a tied result in the final round. He finished 14 goals ahead of second-placed James Freeman (Dandenong Stingrays) and Karl Brown (Calder Cannons).

All four goalkicking winners will be recognised over the next week at the upcoming competition awards nights, starting on Monday (September 7) when we will salute the 2015 J.J. Liston Trophy winner for the fairest and best player in the VFL competition.

The VFL's night of nights this year moves to Palladium at Crown, with a host of talented players to be recognised on the night – with the awarding of the Fothergill-Round Medal (for the most promising young talent), the A. Todd Medal (best and fairest in the AFL Victoria Development League), the VFL Team of the Year and a number of other awards.

Best of luck to all players and clubs during this very exciting time of year.

# Peter Jackson VFL Week 1 Finals preview

## 1st Qualifying Final

**Box Hill Hawks (1st) vs Footscray (4th)**  
**Saturday September 5, 2pm, Box Hill City Oval**

The rematch of last year's Grand Final fittingly pits the VFL's no.1 attacking team in terms of points scored (Hawks) against the league's no.1 defensive team in terms of points conceded (Bulldogs). A lot has changed since Footscray's 2014 flag victory and even since the last time these teams met this season. Back in Round 1 at VU Whitten Oval, Box Hill prevailed by 13 points despite having seven less scoring shots. Joint 'Frosty' Miller Medallist Sam Grimley showed the Bulldogs how to do it, kicking four goals straight for the Hawks, while Dan Howe and Tim O'Brien were also influential with two majors each. Many of Footscray's prime movers that day such as Lachie Hunter, Shane Biggs and Clay Smith won't play on the weekend, but the Dogs still boast potential match-winners like the prolific Brent Prisma and Nathan Hrovat, ruckman Will Minson or key forward Tom Boyd. This will be a fascinating tactical battle mirroring the game styles of their aligned AFL clubs, with Box Hill (similar to Hawthorn) the league's no.1 team for kicks and marks per game and Footscray (similar to the Western Bulldogs) the no.1 team for handballs per game.

## 2nd Qualifying Final

**Sandringham (2nd) vs Williamstown (3rd)**  
**Sunday September 6, 2pm, Trevor Barker Beach Oval**

The Zebras are in the best form of any team in the league, having won seven straight games and 12 of their last 13 to snatch a home final from the Seagulls. The home ground advantage could be crucial too, as Sandringham has won its last six matches at Trevor Barker Beach Oval while Williamstown hasn't played there since Round 20 last year. When these teams last met in Round 2 at Burbank Oval though, it was the Seagulls who showed their dominance, leading all day to record a 58-point victory. Williamstown's Anthony Anastasio booted four goals, while Ben Jolley and Ed Carr (both 31 disposals) ran rampant through the middle. Sandringham is only ranked no.12 in the league for disposals but is the no.1 team for long kicks, getting the ball inside 50 quickly where dynamic forwards Ahmed Saad, Darren Minchington and Eli Templeton can pounce. But Clint Jones and the Zebs' midfield will need to win the ball from the league's no.1 team for contested possessions and clearances. With on-ball guns like Jolley, Adam Marcon and Mitch Banner being fed by ruckman Nick Meese, the Seagulls will be hard to stop.

## 1st Elimination Final

**Essendon (5th) vs Casey Scorpions (8th)**

**Sunday September 6, 11.40am, North Port Oval**

The Bombers double-chance hopes were dashed in the final home-and-away round with Footscray's last-gasp win over Werribee pushing them down into fifth position and into a cut-throat final. Despite a disappointing AFL season, Essendon has shown some depth at VFL level in 2015. The Bombers are ranked no.2 in the league for disposals and second only to Box Hill for kicks and marks, with ball-winners such as Dan Coghlan, James Polkinghorne and Jordan Schroder often racking up big numbers. However, the Scorpions got the best of them in the teams' only 2015 encounter at Windy Hill in Round 3, winning by 33 points after a seven-goal-to-nil third term blew the game open. Rucking has been a key strength of Casey's this year, whether the post has been filled by Max Gawn earlier in the season or Mark Jamar and Jake Spencer more recently. Midfielders such as Matt Jones (30 disposals), Aidan Riley (23) and Rohan Bail (23) feasted on the work of Gawn and Spencer back in May, and will be looking to gain first use of the ball this weekend to nullify Essendon's high-possession game plan.

## 2nd Elimination Final

**Collingwood (6th) vs Werribee (7th)**

**Saturday September 5, 12.10pm, North Port Oval**

The Tigers have taken some big scalps this season – including Box Hill and Williamstown twice each – but at Victoria Park in Round 9, the Magpies were too strong for them. After trailing by 20 points at half time, Collingwood slammed on 10 goals to two behinds in the third quarter to turn the game on its head. Brenden Abbott was the Pies' best with six goals but won't play this weekend, while tough midfielder Ben Moloney (25 disposals, nine tackles) and ruck pairing Mason Cox and Scott Greenhough matched it with Majak Daw and Dan Currie. The Collingwood rucks (likely including Jarrod Witts this time) will need to keep Werribee's big men under control, because the Tiger midfielders might just be the key to this game. Werribee is a strong contested possession team but struggles to hold onto the ball away from the contest, ranking in front of only Frankston in terms of disposals per game. If players like Matt Hanson, Isaac Conway and Will Fordham enjoy silver service at the stoppages, Werribee has the tall timber up forward to trouble a Magpie defence that conceded easily the most points of any top-eight team.

# J. J. Liston Trophy preview

The 2015 J. J. Liston Trophy for the Peter Jackson VFL's best and fairest player will be presented on Monday night. Let's take a look at some of the contenders and why they could be taking home the coveted award.

## **JONATHAN SIMPKIN (Box Hill Hawks)**

The long-time VFL star has continued to find the ball in 2015, averaging 26 disposals in 17 matches.

## **SAM ILES (Box Hill Hawks)**

Iles has again been a consistent ball-winner for the Hawks, averaging 21 disposals over 15 matches.

## **VIV MICHIE (Casey Scorpions)**

The pacy Michie averaged 25 disposals across eight matches for the Scorpions.

## **DANIEL VENDITTI (Coburg)**

A constant in Coburg's midfield, Venditti averaged 25 disposals and six tackles in 18 matches.

## **SAM DWYER (Collingwood)**

Dwyer is still doing what he's always done at VFL level, averaging 20 disposals over 12 matches.

## **SHAUN MCKERNAN (Essendon)**

The 196cm forward/ruckman has stood out in his time at VFL level, booting 14 goals in 10 matches and averaging 20 disposals and 19 hitouts.

## **LACHIE HUNTER (Footscray)**

Hunter has shown what a prolific ball-winner he can be at AFL level recently and averaged an impressive 27 disposals across eight VFL matches earlier in 2015.

## **NATHAN HROVAT (Footscray)**

Having struggled to establish himself in the Bulldogs' AFL team, the diminutive Hrovat has booted 14 goals and averaged 22 disposals in 10 matches at the lower level.

## **BEN CAVARRA (Frankston)**

Cavarra was again a shining light in a dark year for the Dolphins, averaging 20 disposals over 18 matches.

## **GEORGE HORLIN-SMITH (Geelong)**

The 2012 Norm Goss Medallist has averaged 24 disposals in 10 matches for the Cats.

## **MYLES SEWELL (North Ballarat)**

Sewell has had a big season on his return to the Roosters, averaging 22 disposals and six tackles over 18 matches.

## **NICK RIPPON (North Ballarat)**

The Roosters young gun backed up a stellar 2014 season by averaging 24 disposals in 18 matches.

## **BRAD WALSH (Northern Blues)**

Walsh shone in a disappointing year for the Blues, averaging 22 disposals in 16 matches.

## **JORDAN LISLE (Port Melbourne)**

The Borough's powerhouse 196cm recruit has starred up forward across his 18 matches, booting 42 goals and averaging six marks.

## **MATT THOMAS (Richmond)**

The Tigers hard-nut has excelled in the clinches again this season, averaging 22 disposals and seven tackles in 12 matches.

## **CLINT JONES (Sandringham)**

The renowned ball accumulator has lived up to his reputation in 2015, averaging 31 disposals and six tackles over 18 matches.

## **DAN CURRIE (Werribee)**

201cm Currie has been influential as a ruckman/forward, kicking nine goals and averaging 35 hitouts in 11 matches.

## **ISAAC CONWAY (Werribee)**

The young Tigers gun has averaged 22 disposals and seven tackles in 18 matches after arriving from the Brisbane Lions this year.

## **BEN JOLLEY (Williamstown)**

The evergreen Seagulls captain keeps on keeping on, averaging 28 disposals across 18 matches.

## **MITCH BANNER (Williamstown)**

The ex-Port Adelaide AFL player has averaged 26 disposals and booted 16 goals over 18 matches in a brilliant season.

# The VFL's 'Beaten Brigade'

As the Peter Jackson VFL top eight teams commence their quest for premiership glory this weekend, seven clubs are already looking ahead to 2016. Let's take a look at how the season panned out for them.

## **NORTH BALLARAT (9th, 8-10)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Andrew Hooper (36)

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Nick Rippon (238) / Handballs – Nick Rippon (208) / Marks – Tony Lockyer (108)

**Predicted B&F:** Nick Rippon / Myles Sewell

The Roosters moved towards life without Gerard FitzGerald and the partial alignment with North Melbourne in 2016 with an up-and-down season. They suffered some big losses in the early and middle parts of the year on the way to a 3-10 record, but then won five straight matches – including an impressive come-from-behind victory over Collingwood at Victoria Park – to farewell 'Fitzzy' in style. Myles Sewell returned to the club in a co-captaincy role and enjoyed a typically prolific season, while Andrew Hooper was dynamic as a small forward after crossing from the SANFL. In addition, the continued development of young local talent such as Nick Rippon and Tony Lockyer will help set North Ballarat up for its new era as a standalone club.

## **PORT MELBOURNE (10th, 7-11)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Jordan Lisle (42)

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Damian Mascitti (271) / Handballs – Toby Pinwill (249) / Marks – Jordan Lisle (118)

**Predicted B&F:** Toby Pinwill / Nathan Batsanis

The story of the Borough's season revolved around injuries to key players. Chris Cain, James Magner, Josh Scipione, Leigh Osborne and Hugh Sandilands among others all missed significant chunks of the season, adding to a void of experience left by departing champions such as John Baird, Sam Fleming and Shane Valenti. But while last year's minor premiers missed the finals for the first time since 2006, there were certainly positives to come out of 2015. Forward Blake Pearson and ruckman Sam Gilmore look to be players of the future, off-season forward line recruits Jordan Lisle and Khan Haretuku proved a handful for opposition defences, and new captain Toby Pinwill gathered the ball at will. But ultimately, a seven-match losing streak between Rounds 11 and 18 cruelled a season that started brightly.

## **GEELONG (11th, 7-11)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Shane Kersten (13)

**Leading stat winners:** Tom Ruggles (243) / Handballs – Brenton Rees (164) / Marks – Tom Ruggles (96)

**Predicted B&F:** Tom Ruggles

It was a year of transition at both AFL and VFL level for Geelong. Paul Hood took over the VFL coaching reins from Matthew Knights and the combination of Ryan Williams, Ben Raidme, Jackson Hollmer and Jackson Sheringham replaced the retired Dom Gleeson as co-captains. As a result of the AFL Cats giving more games to developing players, the depth of the VFL team suffered. However, the performances of young potential AFL stars such as Jarrad Jansen, Jake Kolodjashnij and Dean Gore, and the stability provided by VFL regulars such as Tom Ruggles, Brenton Rees and Matt Farrelly produced some spectacular results, including two defeats of Werribee – one time in Round 13 through a thrilling Shane Kersten goal on the final siren.

## **COBURG (12th, 7-11)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Daniel Younan (24)

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Ozgur Uysal (287) / Handballs – Daniel Venditti (230) / Marks – Cale Morton (109)

**Predicted B&F:** Daniel Venditti / Ozgur Uysal

The Lions farewellled their seven-year captain Nick Carnell with a year in which finals action was still on the cards ahead of Round 19. However, a hard-fought loss to the Casey Scorpions ended their hopes and saw the immediate retirement of Carnell. The club is well-placed for life without him though, with the likes of Daniel Venditti and Ben Clifton ready to step up and fill the void after outstanding seasons. Ex-AFL player Cale Morton made an impact in his first year at Coburg, Josh Cauchi impressed straight out of the TAC Cup and key-position player Michael Hartley has developed into a possible AFL draftee. The signs are good ahead of a third season as a standalone club, no more evident than in an upset 48-point victory over Footscray in Round 15.

## **RICHMOND (13th, 5-13)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Liam McBean (42)

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Matt Dea (195) / Handballs – Matt Thomas (180) / Marks – Matt Dea (94)

**Predicted B&F:** Jaryd Cachia / Matt Thomas

The Tigers again finished outside the top eight in their second year as a VFL club. Several young AFL-listed players such as Jason Castagna, Matt McDonough and Matt Arnot took regular opportunities to develop their games, while Liam McBean was a joint-winner of the 'Frosty' Miller Medal after a stellar season in front of the big sticks. New recruit and captain Jaryd Cachia won plenty of contested ball in the midfield, while experienced campaigners Nick Wynne and James Wall helped provide the backbone for a youthful team. The clear highlight of 2015 was a stunning final-quarter comeback victory over Port Melbourne at Punt Road Oval in Round 14.

## **NORTHERN BLUES (14th, 4-14)**

**Leading goalkicker:** Matthew Watson / Blaine Johnson (27)

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Tom Fields (228) / Handballs – Brad Walsh (191) / Marks – Tom Wilson (89)

**Predicted B&F:** Brad Walsh

Northern's year was a reflection of Carlton's poor season at AFL level. As injuries and poor form opened the door for developing AFL-listed players to move up to the elite level, the VFL Blues suffered.

2015 started brightly though, with a one-point loss to Williamstown in Round 1 soon followed by six-point win against Sandringham in Round 3. However, an upset four-point victory over Werribee in Round 10 soon gave way to an eight-match losing streak to round out the season. The positives included consistent good form from AFL-listed youngsters such as Brad Walsh, Blaine Johnson and Tom Fields, as well as the emergence of American project player Alex Aurricchio, who established himself as the club's ruckman across 11 matches.

## **FRANKSTON (15th, 0-18)**

**Leading stat winners:** Kicks – Josh Tynan (228) / Handballs – Ben Cavarra (161) / Marks – Corey Buchan (96)

**Predicted B&F:** Ben Cavarra / Jason Pongracic

It's fair to say it wasn't the perfect start to Patrick Hill's time as a senior coach with the Dolphins. Hill oversaw a fruitless campaign in terms of wins, but showed Frankston is still a fruitful breeding ground for potential top-end talent and was recently rewarded with a two-year contract extension. Youngsters Ben Cavarra, Jason Pongracic and Josh Tynan enjoyed stellar seasons, captain Shane Hockey was again important in the midfield and the club's relationship with the Dandenong Stingrays was strengthened through regular appearances from Daniel Capiron, Harrison Prior and Jayden Bubb.

The party really started in the third quarter, when Geelong kept Northern scoreless while booting six goals of its own. Both teams' seasons will end up mirroring those of their affiliated AFL clubs, with the VFL Cats finishing just outside the top eight and the VFL Blues finishing second-last.

The Borough's five-goal-to-two third quarter made things tense for the Pies at Victoria Park, but they steadied late to move into the finals in good form. Collingwood will now face Werribee in an elimination final, while Port Melbourne looks to 2016 hoping for a better run with injuries.

However, Essendon couldn't hold onto fourth position after Footscray defeated Werribee and will now face the Casey Scorpions in an elimination final.

Meanwhile, McBean booted two goals against Essendon in at-times terrible conditions at Windy Hill to edge his way onto the honour roll.



## 1st Qualifying Final

**North Ballarat Rebels (1st) vs Geelong Falcons (4th)**

**Saturday September 5, 2pm, Ikon Park**

The Rebels may have finished the home-and-away season one game clear on top of the ladder, but they'd be worried about having to face the Falcons this week. North Ballarat has lost just three games this year, but two of them were to Geelong. The Falcons held off the Rebels to triumph by two points in Round 1 at Simonds Stadium, but in Round 13 away from home at Eureka Stadium, Geelong showed just how powerful it could be, defeating the ladder leaders by 40 points. Star Falcons pair Rhys Mathieson (30 disposals, 10 clearances, one goal) and Darcy Parish (27 disposals, eight clearances, one goal) were the chief destroyers in the middle, while Brett Blair and Zach Zdybel both booted three goals for Geelong. After missing that match, North Ballarat will benefit from having Jacob Hopper back in the line-up, who had 27 disposals and kicked four goals in the teams' first encounter. The pressure was truly on in Round 13, with both teams recording a huge 116 tackles – expect a similarly fierce contest on the finals stage this weekend.

## 2nd Qualifying Final

The only meeting between Dandenong and Murray this season was billed as the battle of two potential no.1 NAB AFL Draft picks – Stingrays defender Jacob Weiting and Bushrangers forward Josh Schache. In the end, it was Dandenong's back line that ruled the day in a 30-point Round 13 victory at Shepley Oval. The contest was over by half time, when the Stingrays had restricted the Bushrangers to just five behinds and opened up a 43-point lead. Schache booted a goal, but Weiting was one of Dandenong's best with 21 disposals and 12 marks, while Kurt Mutimer (29 disposals, nine inside-50s, seven clearances) was dominant in the middle and James Freeman (three goals) hit the scoreboard. There wasn't much difference between the teams in key statistical indicators that day, with disposals, marks, clearances and tackles all relatively even – instead, the difference was in the Stingrays proving more potent once inside 50. Key Murray midfielders such as Clayton Oliver, Murray Waite and Fletcher Carroll will need to be efficient with their ball use when looking for Schache up forward this weekend.

## 1st Elimination Final

Eastern won four more matches than Calder during the season and will fancy their chances after defeating the Cannons by 26 points at Bayswater Oval in Round 3. 19-year-old Anthony Brolic was superb for the Ranges that day, collecting 21 disposals and taking 11 marks, while ball magnet Ryan Clarke – who is averaging 40 disposals in the last three weeks – had 27 disposals and kicked two goals. In Clarke, James Parsons and Liam Jeffs among others, the Ranges boast a group of classy on-ballers, which means the ruck battle between Eastern's Beau Mitchener (who leads the league in total hitouts) and Calder's Mark Kovacevic (who played eight matches for Coburg in the VFL and Development League this season) for first use of the ball will be crucial.

## 2nd Elimination Final

**Oakleigh Chargers (6th) vs Gippsland Power (7th)**  
**Saturday September 5, 11.30am, Ikon Park**

The Chargers go into this match having lost four of five games since barely defeating Gippsland in the teams' only encounter for 2015 in Round 13 at Warrawee Park. Oakleigh dominated in seemingly every area except on the scoreboard, earning only a three-point victory despite having eight more scoring shots. Led by Lachlan Walker (32 disposals, 12 clearances, 10 inside-50s, one goal), David Cuningham (28 disposals, 10 clearances, seven tackles) and Ben Crocker (25 disposals, eight inside-50s, one goal), the Chargers smashed Gippsland in the centre. They recorded significantly more disposals, hitouts, clearances and inside-50s, but just couldn't turn that into scoreboard dominance, with Jordan Ridley (four behinds) and Dan Houston (1.3) the main culprits. Nash Holmes (26 disposals, 16 tackles, seven clearances, one goal) was a standout for the Power, who will benefit from having Josh Dunkley and Tom Papey alongside him in the middle after they missed the Round 13 clash. Gippsland's twin 200cm towers Harry and Ben McKay (actually twins) will be important in key posts, while classy 17-year-old forward Ben Ainsworth will be one who Oakleigh's defenders need to watch.

# Round 18 Highlights

**The Eastern Ranges were unable to sew up a top-four spot and finals double chance in the last home-and-away round of the TAC Cup season, allowing the Geelong Falcons to swoop into fourth place.**

Eastern ran into a Sandringham Dragons outfit determined to finish off their 2015 season in style at Rams Arena, losing a tense battle by five points after leading by 11 at half time.

The loss proved costly for the Ranges, who started Round 18 in fourth spot – even on premiership points with the fifth-placed Falcons but comfortably ahead on percentage.

A win was all Eastern needed to set up a qualifying final date with the North Ballarat Rebels this week, but Geelong instead seized the chance the Ranges couldn't take.

The Falcons scored a 36-point victory over the second-placed Dandenong Stingrays at Simonds Stadium, despite having only one more scoring shot than their inaccurate opponents.

Dandenong now enter a qualifying final against the Murray Bushrangers, who defeated the Bendigo Pioneers by 66 points in Rochester to seal third position.

In addition to the Ranges, the sixth, seventh and eighth-placed teams also lost last week in less-than-encouraging warm-ups for finals.

The Oakleigh Chargers (6th) went down to minor premier North Ballarat by 34 points at Eureka Stadium, while their opponents in an elimination final this week, the Gippsland Power (7th), were toppled by the 10th-placed Northern Knights at Ikon Park.

Northern's thrilling one-point victory was its second straight to finish the season and came after trailing the Power by 22 points at three-quarter time.

But in perhaps the biggest upset of the round, the Western Jets climbed off the bottom of the ladder by recording just their second victory of 2015 over the Calder Cannons (8th) at Rams Arena.

Fielding a particularly young team, the Jets flew free of their western neighbours in the third term and then weathered a final-quarter comeback to win by nine points.

**40** The Calder Cannons may have had 33 more disposals, 14 more inside-50s and six more scoring shots in their nine-point loss to Western, but the Jets got over the line in no small part due to sticking 40 more tackles than their opponents. Jaycob Hickey (13 tackles) and Brayden Monk (12) led the way for the victors.

**13** Sandringham overcame the Eastern Ranges by getting it done at the coalface. Despite Eastern boasting several quality ball-winners, the Dragons won the ball in the contest – recording 13 more clearances than the Ranges – and then kept it off their opponents by having 68 more disposals. Sandy's chief clearance winner was Fergus Borthwick with nine.

**15** The Dandenong Stingrays will have to clean up their work in front of the big sticks ahead of their qualifying final this week after kicking 3.15 against Geelong. The Falcons only had one more scoring shot than the Rays but still emerged as 36-point winners.

## Hardwick runs away with goalkicking title

Eastern Ranges forward Blake Hardwick was the runaway winner of the TAC Cup goalkicking title after the completion of last week's final home-and-away round.

The 181cm 18-year-old from Doncaster East booted 46 goals from 12 matches in 2015 at an average of 3.8 goals per game, including a bag of eight against the Western Jets in Round 1 and a bag of 10 against the Geelong Falcons in Round 8, with a huge haul of 12 majors coming against the Bendigo Pioneers in Round 16.

Hardwick kicked 24 goals in 16 TAC Cup matches last year.

Sharing second on the goalkicking table was Calder Cannon Karl Brown (32 goals from 10 games) and Dandenong Stingray James Freeman (32 from 15 games), just ahead of possible no.1 NAB AFL Draft pick Josh Schache of the Murray Bushrangers (30 from eight games).

### 2015 stats leaders

With the home-and-away rounds of the TAC Cup season behind us, let's take a look at which players scorched the stats sheets in terms of total numbers in 2015.

**King Kick: Brayden Fiorini** (Northern Knights)

Fiorini and his side-'kick' at the Knights, **Jade Gresham**, topped this category in 2015 with 279 and 274 kicks respectively, ahead of Bendigo Pioneer **Lachie Tardrew** with 261. Impressively, both Fiorini and Gresham did so playing only 13 out of a possible 17 games.

**Handball Happy: Lachie Tardrew** (Bendigo Pioneers)

Tardrew was a disposal machine during his 16 matches for the Pioneers, finishing third in total kicks and racking up 208 handballs to take out this category. Just behind was Murray Bushranger **Clayton Oliver** with 204 and then Tardrew's Bendigo teammate **Joseph Atley** with 172.

**Mark Master: Brayden Fiorini** (Northern Knights)

Not surprisingly – given he topped the kick category – Fiorini had the ball sent his way plenty of times in 2015, taking 108 marks. This was just ahead of the Eastern Ranges' **Anthony Brolic** on 107, while Murray overage tall **Nick Coughlan** took 79 grabs.

**Top Tackler: Aaron Fenton** (Eastern Ranges)

Tenacious 173cm Fenton was far and away the competition's pressure king, recording 161 tackles in 15 games, 43 more than Western Jet **Jackson Volpato** on 118. North Ballarat Rebel **Joseph Symons** was third in this category with 105 tackles.

**Hitout Hero: Beau Mitchener** (Eastern Ranges)

The top three for total hitouts in 2015 were well clear of the rest of the rucking field, headed by Mitchener on 457. Gippsland Power's **Josh Patullo** was next on 385, just ahead of Oakleigh Charger **Michael Wenn** with 373 – 118 hitouts in front of the next best.

### TAC Youth Girls Academies expand

**AFL Victoria's TAC Youth Girls Academy program will expand to eight regions in 2016, with new Academies to be established in Bendigo and Gippsland.**

The Academies will pilot a new structure – to be managed by the regions' Talent Managers instead of AFL Victoria's Head Office as they have previously.

The Youth Girls Academies aim to prepare Victoria's most promising Youth Girls for representative and senior football via an on and off-field development program that complements their club football experience.

Girls in each of the new regions will benefit from a similar program that is delivered to the boys in the U18 TAC Cup system, as the new Academies utilise the same resources such as facilities and coaches.

The development of the two new Academies will assist in aligning a number of players closer to home, opening the program to new talent in each of the regions.

Bendigo Pioneers Talent Manager Stephen Sharp said it is a great opportunity to provide the same resources for talented boys and girls in the region.

"We are really excited about it and are looking forward to blending the Youth Girls Academy into our current program," Sharp said.

"The girls will be able to experience the same program provided to the boys as we bring together both programs under the one umbrella, utilising the same resources for both groups."

In Gippsland, travel times for Academy players will be cut significantly for those that had previously been in the Dandenong Stingrays-based program.

Gippsland Power Talent Manager Peter Francis said the new Academy will be a natural extension of the Youth Girls Shield side the region introduced last year.

"A number of the parents and players already training for the Youth Girls Shield this year were really keen for us to have an Academy, as the players from places like East Gippsland have extremely long travel times to the other academies," Francis said.

"It will help create a pathway for local girls, with the Youth Girls Shield, the Youth Girls Academy, as well as the new VWFL team that has been established in the Gippsland region."

Trials will begin soon for the new Bendigo and Gippsland Academies, with a squad of 34 to be selected for each, along with the addition of a rookie squad of 10.

In a further change to the Academy program in 2016, all eight Academies will compete in a pre-season competition in February/March next year.




- Assistance in creating a club culture that will help attract new participants to your club, and retain those you already have
- Support to become a community leader in responsible gambling practices
- Community recognition for being a responsible gambling club

AFL Victoria encourages all clubs to sign up to the program, as we believe gambling is a growing concern for youth and sporting clubs across the state. The program offers clubs a fantastic opportunity to increase their awareness and knowledge of the risks associated with gambling for free.

### Teddy and Spud bring up 250

**Two of the most reliable AFL defenders of the past decade reached their 250-game milestones last weekend.**

Sydney's 2012 premiership-winning key defender Ted Richards, 32, brought up his milestone when the Swans defeated St Kilda at Etihad Stadium on Sunday.

The former Sandringham Dragon and 2012 All Australian was originally selected by Essendon with pick no.27 in the 2000 AFL Draft and played 33 games for the Bombers before being traded to Sydney ahead of the 2006 season.

Ex-Eastern Ranges defender Michael Firrito played his 250th match for North Melbourne when the Kangaroos lost to the Western Bulldogs at Etihad Stadium on Saturday.
