TIME KEEPER'S TIME ON /OFF

Time at the start of the quarter

• Clock starts when ball is at the "peak" of the bounce or toss.

Clock Stops - Goal

- If a goal is scored when the goal umpire's flags are crossed.
- And restarts when the ball is at the "peak" of the bounce or toss.

Clock Stops - Behind

- If a goal is scored when the goal umpire waves his flag for the first time.
- And restarts when the player "kicks the ball" after the behind.

Clock Stops - General Play

- When the umpire raises his arm vertically and blows his whistle.
- And restarts when the umpire raises his arm vertically and blows his whistle a second time.

Clock Stops - Out of Bounds and Out of Bounds on the Full

- When the boundary umpire signals that the football is out of bounds or out of bounds on the full.
- And restarts when the football is thrown back by the boundary umpire or brought back into play by a player.
