Roles and Responsibilities of the North Eastern COLTS Football League Committee.

Purpose

- Junior Football is an integral part of the North Eastern Football League.
- Effective management requires identification and direction of responsibilities and regular monitoring from all clubs with in the association.
- This document identifies the Junior Football Committees responsibilities within the NEFL Association, so that each person can effectively contribute to the improvement of football.

Scope

• This document covers all delegates who are elected by their registered club

Responsibility

• North Eastern Junior Football League Committee

Reporting To - North Eastern Football League President/Senior Executive/Senior Delegates.

Chairperson – Vice President of the North Eastern Football League

Committee/Delegates: To consist of one/two delegates from each registered club.

1 x Junior Development Officer (Woodville/West Torrens

Representative)

1 x Minute taker elected from within the Junior Committee.

Role Statement

- Manage and co-ordinate all aspects of Junior Football within the North Eastern Football League.
- Provide relevant, up to date and timely advice to the North Eastern Football league Senior Committee.
- Provide direction and assistance to NEFL Senior Committee.

General Responsibilities

- Meet monthly
- Elect permit committee (refer NEFL constitution)
- Organise the best and fairest medal count including venue
- Oversee all Junior NEFL inter association games (Under age competitions)
 - Advertise for coaching positions
 - Interview prospective coaches and recommend an appointment to senior management
 - Appoint team managers and runners
 - Form a squad of players (Refer to constitution)
 - Organise training times and venues
