

### 2010 AREA AGREEMENT - JUNIOR LEAGUE/JUNIOR LEAGUE

### An agreement between the Shepparton District JFL Under 16's. and the Goulburn Campaspe JFL

This agreement is only to allow Under 14 players in the Goulburn Campaspe JFL to be able to play with their clubs "name-sake" Under 16 team in the Shepparton DJFL. [Kyabram Secondary College is the "name sake club" for School teams in Kyabram].

This agreement is signed pursuant to the Victorian Country Football League Incorporated Rules and Regulations pertaining to clearances and permits and in particular clause 2.10 whereby an interchange of players between Clubs of the above-mentioned Leagues may take place without clearance and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

### PROVIDED HOWEVER:

- (i) That this Agreement is in force for the current season only.
- (ii) That prior to each match played, the player shall obtain written permission to do so from his parent club. The permit shall be in triplicate similar to a one day permit form and dispersed as required under Regulation 2.1 of the VCFL Rules and Regulations.
- (iii) That this agreement cannot be altered unless agreed to by the Area Manager.
- (iv) That in order for a player playing under such Area Permit to participate in a finals series in that season the player must have played a minimum of **three (3) games** in the team of the grade in which he has been selected to play in the finals and has met any additional league eligibility requirements.

### **LOCAL CONDITIONS:**

#### 1. INTERCHANGE OF PLAYERS

- GCJFL players are permitted 6 permits to play in the SDJFL season (including finals).
  - The total number of permits must not exceed 6

### 2. FINALS PERMITS & ELIGIBILITY

- GCJFL U14 players are permitted to play in the SDJFL Finals
- The player must have played a minimum of **three (3)** games in the team of the grade in which he has been selected to play in the finals and has met any additional league eligibility requirements.
- The total number of permits must not exceed 6

## 3. GAMES PER DAY/WEEKEND

- Players **are** permitted to play 2 games per weekend provided:
  - o no more than **20** players, including permit players, appear on the **SDJFL** team sheet; and
  - o that the player is playing for his "namesake or league nominated" club(s)
  - Club registered players must be selected before permit players can receive endorsement to play.

## 4. NUMBER OF PERMITS

- Teams are only permitted **6** permit players in any one match.

### 5. PERMITS AND CLEARANCES

 A player who has played 6 matches on permit in the SDJFL may seek a clearance after July 1<sup>st</sup> in accordance with VCFL Rule 2.1.

#### 6. REPORTED PLAYERS

- A player playing on permit that is reported shall face the Tribunal of the League of which the offence was committed. Any penalty that is imposed shall apply in all competitions.

### 7. PERMIT BREACHES

- Any breach of Permit arrangements and agreements will be referred to the VCFL under Rule 1.3 – Penalty for playing ineligible or unregistered players

# 8. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- The Team Sheet may have a full complement of 22 Players listed if player is only playing ONE game in a weekend.

This agreement is valid and will remain current unless endorsed by the WorkSafe VCFL North East Area Manager
