

The areas that must be addressed prior to next seasons A grade squads are:


- 1. Full commitment to all trainings and games compulsory





Stephanie Templeman:


A Devils player for the last two seasons. Plays catcher for the team and has really put in some hard work on throwing long distances. Keep up the good work Stephanie.


