PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- That you will abide by the policy and guidelines of the statutory requirements of the Northern Territory legislation in relation to Working with Children, and ASBA's sports rage guidelines.
- Play by the rules
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, coach, or manager approach the referee during a break or after the game in an appropriate manner.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in basketball.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your team's performance will benefit so will you.
- Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good plays whether they are your team or the other team.
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully, or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Co-operate with your coach, team mates, and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Play for the "Fun of it" and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Avoid use of derogatory language based of gender, race, or impairment.
- Be prepared to lose sometimes. Everyone wins and loses at some time. Be a fair winner and a good loser

NOTE: A player who breaches this code can be expected to be put on a player behaviour agreement, irrespective of the outcome of any other disciplinary action.
